## MATERIALS

- » Pencil
- » Fabric scissors
- » Measuring tape
- » Iron


## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS


## 2 (two) 8 1/2" x 22" Strip

NOTE: The longest measurement might vary depending on your head measurement, keep in mind that the fabric is very stretchy if you are modifying any measurements

## INSTRUCTIONS


- Take one of the 8 1/2" x 22 strip.
- Place the strip right side of fabric facing you and fold the long edges toward the center, so both ends will meet at the center.
- Iron if
- Sew the edges together with 1/4" seam allowance to close it.
- press seams open (DIAGRAM 1).
- Turn the strip right side out
- $\bullet$  Repeat the previous steps with the strip that is left  $$\tt DIAGRAM1$$






Align them to the center making a swiss cross

DIAGRAM 2




- Take the right side of the bottom strip and cross it over to the left side.
- Sew the raw edge to close that end

DIAGRAM 3



- Now repeat the previous step with the other strip
- take the bottom part of the other piece and cross it upwards towards the top
- Sew the raw edge to close the strip


