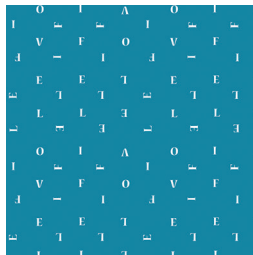

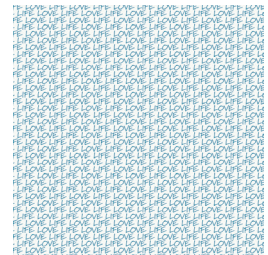

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric <b>A</b>	CAP-L-3002	FQ.
Fabric <b>B</b>	CAP-L3004	F8.
Fabric <b>C</b>	CAP-L-3007	F8.
Fabric <b>D</b>	CAP-L-3001	7/8 yd.
Fabric <b>E</b>	CAP-L-3000	F8.
Fabric <b>F</b>	P.E- 413	1/6 yd.
Fabric <b>G</b>	P.E- 430	F8.
Fabric <b>H</b>	P.E- 458	F8.
Fabric <b>I</b>	P.E- 422	F8.

### BACKING FABRIC

Fabric **D** included.

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

*1/4" seam allowances are included.  
WOF means width of fabric.*

One (1) 12½' x 12½' square from fabric **A**

Two (2) 12½' x 2½' strips from fabric **F**

Two (2) 16½' x 2½' strips from fabric **F**

One (1) 7' x 1½' strip from fabric **E**

One (1) 8½' x 2½' strip from fabric **D**

One (1) 7' x 1' strip from fabric **B**

One (1) 2' x ½' strip from fabric **I**

One (1) 2' x ½' strip from fabric **H**

One (1) 1' x 1' square from fabric **G**

Two (2) 16' x 12' rectangles from fabric **D**

## CONSTRUCTION

*Sew all rights sides together with 1/4" seam allowance.*

- Firstly, take both pieces of fabric **H** and **G** and sew them side by side.

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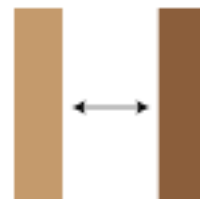


DIAGRAM 1

- Now take the 1' x 1' square from Fabric **G** and sew on top of the piece.
- Also sew the 7' x 1' strip from fabric **B** to the bottom.



DIAGRAM 2

- Next, take all the strip pieces and add steam a seam to the wrong side of the fabric. ( Fabrics **E**, **D**, **B**, **I**, **H**, and **G** ).
- Once the steam a seam is applied begin to place each strip piece in the order of as seen in the cover.
- Next sew the two (2) 12½' x 2½' strips from fabric **F** to the side of your 12' x 12' square.



DIAGRAM 3

- Next sew the two (2)  $16\frac{1}{2}' \times 2\frac{1}{2}'$  strips from fabric **F** to the bottom and top of the block.

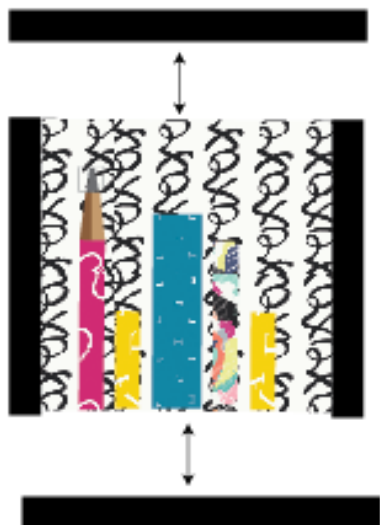

## CREATING THE BACK PILLOW

*Sew all rights sides together with  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press open.*

- To make a envelope back for your pillow take both  $16' \times 12'$  rectangles and fold one  $12'$  side on each rectangle in  $\frac{1}{2}'$  and press and then fold another  $\frac{1}{2}'$  and press.
- Top stitch as close to the edge as possible.
- Place rectangles right side together on top of each other to the front of your pillow and stitch all the way around your pillow at  $\frac{1}{4}'$  seam allowance.
- Clip corners at seam allowance and flip piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill pillow with a  $16' \times 16'$  pillow form and enjoy!
