

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric A CAP-L-3002 FQ.
Fabric B CAP-L3004 F8.
Fabric C CAP-L-3007 F8.
Fabric D CAP-L-3001 76 yd.
Fabric E CAP-L-3000 F8.
Fabric F P.E- 413 16 yd.
Fabric G P.E- 430 F8.
Fabric H P.E- 458 F8.
Fabric I P.E- 422 F8.

BACKING FABRIC

Fabric D included.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

One (1) 12½' x 12½' square from fabric A

Two (2) 12½' x 2½' strips from fabric F

Two (2) 16½" x 2½" strips from fabric F

One (1) 7" \times 1½" strip from fabric **E**

One (1) 8½" x 2½" strip from fabric D

One (1) 7" x 1" strip from fabric B

One (1) 2" x 1/2" strip from fabric I

One (1) 2" x ½" strip from fabric H

One (1) 1" x 1" square from fabric G

Two (2) 16" x 12" rectangles from fabric ${\bf D}$

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with 1/4" seam allowance.

• Firstly, take both pieces of fabric **H** and **G** and sew them side by side.




DIAGRAM 1

 Now take the 1' x 1' square from Fabric G and sew on top of the piece.

 Also sew the 7' x 1' strip from fabric B to the bottom.



DIAGRAM 2

- Next, take all the strip pieces and add steam a seam to the wrong side of the fabric. (Fabrics E, D, B, I, H, and G).
- Once the steam a seam is applied begin to place each strip piece in the order of as seen in the cover.
- Next sew the two (2) 12½' x 2½' strips from fabric **F** to the side of your 12' x 12' square.




DIAGRAM 3

• Next sew the two (2) 16½' x 2½' strips from fabric **F** to the bottom and top of the block.



DIAGRAM 4

CREATING THE BACK PILLOW

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance. Press open.

- To make a envelope back for your pillow take both 16' x 12' rectangles and fold one 12' side on each rectangle in 1/2' and press and then fold another 1/2' and press.
- Top stitch as close to the edge as possible.
- Place rectangles right side together on top of each other to the front of your pillow and stitch all the way around your pillow at 1/4" seam allowance.
- Clip corners at seam allowance and flip piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill pillow with a 16' x 16' pillow form and enjoy!
