CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

All block pieces are cut from pattern templates found at the end of these instructions. Glue these pages together and cut your templates out. For easier cutting back the templates with (or trace onto) cardstock or posterboard.

Fabric **A**: Cut three (3) Block A- Piece 1
Cut three (3) Block A- Piece 3
Cut two (2) Block B- Piece 1
Cut sixteen (16) Block B- Dresden Plate
Cut three (3) Block C- Piece 1
Cut three (3) Outer Block

Fabric **B**: Cut three (3) Block A- Piece 2
Cut three (3) Outer Block

Fabric **C**: Cut three (3) Block A- Piece 4

Fabric **D**: Cut three (3) Block A- Piece 3
Cut three (3) Block B- Dresden Plate

Fabric **E**: Cut three (3) Block A- Piece 2
Cut three (3) Block A- Piece 3
Cut five (5) Outer Block

Fabric **F**: Cut two (2) Block A- Piece 3

Fabric **G**: Cut two (2) Block A- Piece 1
Cut two (2) Block A- Piece 4
Cut three (3) Outer Block
Cut five (5) Block B- Piece 1
Cut two (2) Block B- Dresden Center

Fabric **H**: Cut three (3) Block A- Piece 3

Fabric **O**: Cut three (3) Block A- Piece 4

Fabric **P**: Cut three (3) Outer Block

Fabric **Q**: Cut three (3) Block B- Piece 1
Cut three (3) Block B- Piece 1
Cut three (3) Block C- Piece 1

Fabric **R**: Cut six (6) Outer Block
Cut ten (10) Block B- Dresden Plate
Cut two (2) Block B- Dresden Center

Fabric **S**: Cut three (3) Block A- Piece 2
Cut two (2) Outer Block
Cut eight (8) Block B- Dresden Plate


Set aside fabric remnants from Fabrics **B, C, D, G, H, I, L, M & R** for paper piecing the middle sections on blocks B.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with 1/4" seam allowance.

Block A

- Gather all Block A pieces (and Outer Circle Pieces) and press each piece in half so that you can easily match centers when pinning. When sewing curved pieces together pin the concave piece onto of the convex piece (ie. Pin 2 to 1, with 1 on the bottom). First pin the edges and match the center marks, then pin the rest of the piece and sew at 1/4" seam allowance. Make block A blocks in the following fabric combinations:



- **Block A1**- Make 3

1: Fabric **N** > 2: Fabric **B** > 3: Fabric **A** > 4: Fabric **L** > 5: Fabric **P**



- **Block A2**- Make 3

1: Fabric **A** > 2: Fabric **S** > 3: Fabric **H** > 4: Fabric **C** > 5: Fabric **E**




- **Block A3**- Make 2

1: Fabric **G** > 2: Fabric **I** > 3: Fabric **F** > 4: Fabric **G** > 5: Fabric **S**



- **Block A4**- Make 3

1: Fabric **J** > 2: Fabric **L** > 3: Fabric **E** > 4: Fabric **J** > 5: Fabric **G**




- **Block A5**- Make 3

1: Fabric **K** > 2: Fabric **E** > 3: Fabric **D** > 4: Fabric **O** > 5: Fabric **M**


- Press carefully and trim all blocks to 10 1/2" square. Blocks must be trimmed. Set aside.

Block B

- Sew pattern pieces 1 to Outer Block Piece the same as for Block A and trim blocks to 10 1/2" square.
- Sew the top of the Dresden Plate pieces into points by folding the top in half, right sides together and sewing across the top. Snip the corner with the fold of fabric and then flip right side out and press down to make the point. See Diagram below.



- Sew the 4 Dresden Plate petals to each other and applique to the corner of the block.
- Turn over the curved edge of the Dresden center circle applique piece by cutting out the pressing template from cardstock or freezer paper and pressing the curved edge over it. Then, applique to the corner of the block.
