FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric A CAP-VC-5004 ½ yd.
Fabric B CAP-VC-5003 ¼ yd.
Fabric C NE-111 ¼ yd.

BACKING FABRIC
Fabric A CAP-VC-5004 (Included)

CUTTING DIRECTIONS


1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

- Two (2) $15\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from fabric A.
- Seven (7) Hexie Pattern from fabric A.
- Eight (8) Hexie Pattern from fabric B.
- Ten (10) Hexie Pattern from fabric C.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

• Sew your hexagons into columns. Starting and stopping ½" on each end. It's very important you don't sew all the way to the end! Backstitch at the start and the end.





• Column 1: B-A-C-B

open.

• Column 2: C-C-A-A-A

• Column 3: B-A-C-A

• Column 4: C-B-B-C-C

• Column 5: B-A-C-A




DIAGRAM 2

- Start sewing your columns together by laying your first twocolumns right sides together lining up your first two hexagons.
- Meet the raw edges and sew ¼" in and stop ¼" before the end of your hexagon edge.




DIAGRAM 3

- To sew your next seam, fold top hexagon from fabric B so you will be able to line up your seams easily because you left 1/4" gaps.
- Continue sewing each hexagon using this method to attach all your columns.

 Once you have assembled all columns, you will have to square your piece to a 14½" square.






DIAGRAM 5

CREATING THE BACK PILLOW

Sew all rights sides together with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press open.

- Take both $15\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10" rectangles from fabric **A**.
- Fold one 15½" edge ½" towards the wrong side of the fabric of each rectangle.
- Fold the same edge ½" again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric A and align it wrong side up to the top side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric A and align it wrong side up to the bottom side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at 1/4".
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a 14" pillow form and enjoy!
