



FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric **A** GHT-47506 Fat 8.
 Fabric **B** GTH-37506 ½ yd.
 Fabric **C** GTH-37502 Fat Q.
 Fabric **D** GTH-37503 ¼ yd.
 Fabric **E** PE-452 Fat Q.

BACKING FABRIC
 GTH-37506 (Included)

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

- Two (2) 4⅞" squares from fabric **A**.
- Three (3) 4⅞" squares from fabric **B**.
- Six (6) 4⅞" squares from fabric **C**.
- Eight (8) 4⅞" squares from fabric **D**.
- Five (5) 4⅞" squares from fabric **E**.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance.

- Take two (2) 4⅞" squares and place them right sides facing.
- Draw a line diagonally corner to corner using a mechanical pencil or frixion pen.
- Stitch ¼" on each side of the drawn lines.
- Cut the pieces apart along the marked diagonal line.
- Press and trim to 4½" square.




DIAGRAM 1

- Take one (1) 4⅞" square from fabrics **A** and **B** and create a total of two (2) **AB**.




DIAGRAM 2

- Take one (1) 4⅞" square from fabrics **A** and **E** and create a total of two (2) **AE**.




DIAGRAM 3

- Take two (2) 4⅞" squares from fabrics **C** and **B** and create a total of four (4) **CB**.




DIAGRAM 4

- Take four (4) 4⅞" squares from fabrics **C** and **D**.
- Because fabric **D** is a directional fabric, create two (2) hst's cutting the fabric from left to right and the other two (2) cut the hst from right to left. Create a total of four (4) **CD** following the diagram below.



DIAGRAM 5

- Take four (4) 4⅞" squares from fabrics **D** and **E**.
- Repeat the same instruction for the direction of the fabric.
- Create a total of four (4) **DE** following the diagram below.




DIAGRAM 6

CREATING THE BACK PILLOW

- Assemble each HST following the diagram below.




DIAGRAM 7

- Now, join each row.




DIAGRAM 8

- Take both 16½" x 12" rectangles from fabric **C**.
- Fold one bottom edge ½" towards the wrong side of the fabric of one of the rectangle.
- Fold the same edge ½" again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Repeat the same for the top edge of the bottom piece.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric **C** and align it wrong side up to the right side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric **C** and align it wrong side up to the left side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at ¼".
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a 16" x 16" pillow form and enjoy!


