



HME-70402 4 Fat Quarter (Suggested)

TRIM

Pom-pom Trim 1 ¾ yd.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Seam allowances vary from ½" to ¼"please refer to directions.

One (1) 3.25"x13" strip from fabric A

One (1) 3.25"x13" strip from fabric B

One (1) 3.25"x13" strip from fabric C

One (1) 3.25"x13" strip from fabric D

One (1) 3.25"x13" strip from fabric E

One 10'x10' square from fabric G

Cut 2' around a heart from fabric F

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all seams on pillow top with ½ "seam allowance.

- Sew together your strips at ½' seam allowance.
 Sew in order: A>B>C>D>E
- Press.



• Cut four (4) strips, each 31/4' wide. Set aside strips.

Heart Assembly

- Pin the heart to the back of the linen fabric, carefully center the heart.
- You will sew on the top side of the linen, without the benefit of being able to see the heart so make sure to transfer a sewing guideline in the way you feel most comfortable.
- You will sew ½" away from the edge of the heart.
- To mark sewing line:
 - Place your heart on paper and trace ½' around it with a tracing wheel. Now fold the paper, true the heart shape.
 and cut out.
 - Center your paper heart on fabric heart, and transfer sewing lines with tracing wheel or removable marker.
- Choose your favorite decorative stitch and stitch around heart.

- Now, pinch the heart fabric and pull away from the linen, carefully snip into the center of the linen and trim the linen ¼' away from decorative stitching.
- Gently fray the raw linen edge by rubbing between your fingers.

- Sew strips around linen heart center with 1/2' seam allowance.
- Sew strips to the edge of the linen, aligning Fabric E with the edge, and letting Fabric A overhang one end for the first strip.
- For second and third strips, align Fabric A at each corner matching seams with Fabric E
- For last strip, align in the same manner, but carefully stop at ½' from edge of strip and linen, backtack. Now take remaining edges of strips one and four and sew at ½', carefully matching center point. (another option-- seamrip overhaning square off first strip, sew to end of fourth strip, and sew to edge in one go.)



DIAGRAM 4

- At this point add some batting to the back of the pillow top if you'd like.
- Suggested-- Quilt ¼' on either side of the linen/ strip seams, pivoting at corners. Baste edges together, trim any excess batting off.
- Now take pom-pom trim and baste to the edge of the pillow, starting 2' away from a bottom corner, pivot around corners and overlap the beginning edge slightly, trim.
- Using your zipper foot will be helpful with the trim.
- Prepare envelope pillow back from backing fabric.
 - Cut one rectangle 14½ x 10.
 - Cut one rectangle 14½ x 7.
 - On one 14½' side on each piece, hem edge by folding over ½' twice and edge stitching.
- Place back pieces over the top, overlapping so that all edges match up, pin.



- Now we will sew all around the edges at a ¼' seam allowance. Use zipper foot.
- Turn pillow right side out and stuff with a 14'x14' pillow form.
- Enjoy!
