

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

BACKING FABRIC LGD-39700 (Included)

BINDING FABRIC

LGD-49710 (Fabric C) (Included)

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

For template a

- One (1) 15" x 10" rectangle from fabric D for the backing or inside of the bag.
- Improvise cutting pieces and join them as you go with fabrics A, C, D, E, and F.until you get a 15" x 10" rectangle or bigger.

For template b

- One (1) 13" x 9" rectangle from fabric D for the backing or inside of the bag.
- Improvise cutting pieces and join them as you go with fabrics A, C, D, E, and F.until you get a 13" x 9" rectangle or bigger.



For template c

- One (1) 11" x 8" rectangle from fabric D for the backing or inside of the bag.
- Improvise cutting pieces and join them as you go with fabrics A, C, D, E, and F.until you get a 11" x 8" rectangle or bigger.
- 2" bias binding from fabric C.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance. HST means Half Square Triangles.

- Layer the pieced rectangle, the batting, and the rectangle from fabric D.
- Cut the template.



DIAGRAM 1

- Fold the binding in half lenghtwise and press.
- Pin the unfolded side of the binding to the edge of the pieced side.
- Stitch at 1/4".





DIAGRAM 2

• Fold the bias tape towards the backing and hand stitch it in place.



DIAGRAM 3

- Fold your piece to find the center on both sides.
- .Pin the zipper around the edge following Diagram 4.
- Sew the zipper to the bag. starting 2 " away from the center on both sides.
- For fabric placement and zipper attachmet follow Diagram 4.



DIAGRAM 4

- Make sure to close the zipper at least half way.
- Hold the zipper tape from the corners of the bag.
- Saw at 1½" from the edge.
- Repeat on the other side.




DIAGRAM 5

• Remove the pins so the zipper tape falls in place and stitch again.



DIAGRAM 6

• Trim at $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the stitch and clean it with the bias binding tape.



DIAGRAM 7

 Turn it to the right side and enjoy your beautiful Stories Bag!
