FINISHED SIZE | 16" x 16"

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric **A** FUS-AD-160g $\frac{3}{4}$ yd.
Fabric **B** PE-473 $\frac{1}{4}$ yd.
Fabric **C** PE-461 $\frac{1}{6}$ yd.

BACKING FABRIC

Fabric **G** FUS-AD-160g - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

$\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.

- Eight (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ " strips from Fabric **A**
- Four (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ " strips from Fabric **B**
- Three (3) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ " strips from Fabric **C**

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

- Join the following strips together

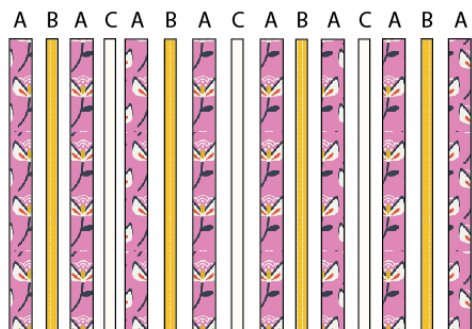


DIAGRAM 1

- Rotate your piece at a 45 degree angle, and cut a $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " square

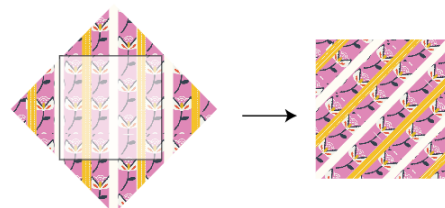


DIAGRAM 2

CREATING THE BACK PILLOW

Sew all rights sides together with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.
Press open.

- To make a envelope back for your pillow take both $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12" rectangles and fold one 12" side on each rectangle in $\frac{1}{2}$ " and press and then fold another $\frac{1}{2}$ " and press.
- Top stitch as close to the edge as possible.
- Place rectangles right side together on top of each other to the front of your pillow and stitch all the way around your pillow at $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.
- Clip corners at seam allowance and flip piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill pillow with a 16" x 16" pillow form and enjoy!
