## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric A SMS-83207 1/8 yd.
Fabric B SMS-83203 1/8 yd.
Fabric C SMS-73201 1/8 yd.
Fabric D SMS-73206 1/4 yd.
Fabric E SMS-73204 1/4 yd.
Fabric F SMS-73207 1/2 yd.
Fabric G PE-426 5/8 yd.

BACKING FABRIC
Fabric G PE-426 (Included)

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included.

- One (1) 2" $\times$ WOF from fabric A.
- One (1) 2" x WOF from fabrics B.
- One (1) 2" $\times$ WOF from fabrics C.
- Three (3) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF from fabric F.
- Five (5) triangle templates from fabric D.
- Five (5) triangle templates from fabric G.
- Five (5) triangle templates from fabric E.
- One (1) $20^{1} 122^{\prime \prime} \times 17^{112 / 2}$ from fabric G.


## CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

- Take the WOF strips from fabrics A, B, C and the three strips from fabric $F$.
- Attach one (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip from fabric A to one (1) $4^{11 / 2 "} \times$ WOF strip from fabric $F$ and one (1) 2 " $\times$ WOF strip from strip $C$ with one (1) $41 / 2 "$ x WOF strip from fabric $F$.
- Join one (1) 2" x WOF strip from fabric B with one (1) $4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip from fabric F and use the template to cut four (4) BF triangles.


DIAGRAM 1

- Now that you have your combined triangles ready, take fabrics D, E and G triangles and the assembled triangles and join them by rows following the diagram below.
- Then, join rows 1-4.


DIAGRAM 2

- Trim it to a $20^{1 / 2 "} \times 17^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangle.


DIAGRAM 3

CREATING THE BACK PILLOU
Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance. Press open.

- Take both $201 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles from fabric G .
- Fold one bottom edge $1 / 2$ " towards the wrong side of the fabric of one of the rectangle.
- Fold the same edge $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Repeat the same for the top edge of the bottom piece.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric A and align it wrong side up to the right side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric A and align it wrong side up to the left side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a $20 " \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ pillow form and enjoy!
