APPLETINI

- Take the triangle template and place it on top of one of your SS1. Trace and cut.
- Make sure to align the wider part of the template to fabric C strip. Repeat the same for the rest of SS1, creating a total of four (4) triangle strip set 1.




DIAGRAM 3

- Repeat the same for SS2 creating a total of four (4) triangle strip set 2. Trace and cut.
- Make sure to align the wider part of the template to fabric C strip.




DIAGRAM 4

- Take two (2) SS1 and two (2) SS2 and join them following the diagram below.




DIAGRAM 5

- Take the remaining two (2) SS1 and two (2) SS2 and join them following the diagram below.




DIAGRAM 6

- Repeat the same for the other 21" square from fabric C but on the opposite direction.


