## A-Round Pillowi

FINISHED SIZE $24^{\circ} \times 24$

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric A KUS-23702 1/3 Yd.
Fabric B KUS-23704 11⁄8 Yd.
Fabric C KUS-23706 3/4 Yd.
Fabric D KUS-23709 3/4 Yd.
Fabric E KUS-23711 5/8 Yd.
Fabric F PE-433 1 Yd
Fabric G PE-495 $\quad 1 / 4 \mathrm{Yd}$.
BACKING FABRIC
KUS-23706 3/4 Yd. (included)
Piping FABRIC
PE-495 (Fabric G) (included)

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

Four (4) $211 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips from fabric A.
Fifteen (15) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric $B$

One (1) Circle template from fabric C.
Two (2) $141 / 2 " \times 24^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles from fabric C.
Nine (g) $2^{1 ⁄ 2 "} \times$ WOF strips from fabric D.
Eight (8) $2^{1 ⁄ 21} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric $E$.
Four (4) $4 ½ " \times$ WOF strips from fabric F.
Six (6) $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric $F$.
Three (3) 2" $\times$ WOF strips from fabric G.

Sew all rights sides together with 1/4"seam allowance.

- Start constructing Strip set 1.
- Take four $2112 " \times$ WOF strips from fabric B and three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric $D$.
- Attach the strips in the following order BDBDBDB.

- Subcut into sixteen (16) 2 1/2" strips


DIAGRAM 1

- Now, continue with Strip set 2.
- Take four $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips from fabric $D$ and three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric B.
- Attach the strips in the following order DBDBDBD.

- Subcut into sixteen (16) 2 1/2" strips


DIAGRAM 2

- Continue with Strip set 3
- Take two $2 \not 1 ⁄ 2 " \times$ WOF strips from fabric D and B.
- Attach the strips in the following order DBDB.
- Subcut into Fourteen (14) 2 1/2" strips.

- Take two Strip set 1 and one Strip set 2.


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- Attach them in the order Strip set 1- Strip set 2Strip set 1. Make four for this combination.


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DIAGRAM 4

- Take two Strip set 2 and one Strip set 1.


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- Attach them in the order Strip set 2- Strip set 1Strip set 2. Make six for this combination.


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DIAGRAM 5

- Set the remaining Strip set 2 and Strip set 3 aside for upcoming steps.
- Take two strips sets from diagram 5 and one strip set from Diagram 4.
- Attach them alternating the strip set to create a Grid Set as shown in the diagram below.
- Make three (3) for Grid Sets.


DIAGRAM 6

- Take the remaining Strip set 2 and Strip set 3 to create one more Grid Set.
- Now, it is time to create a Set 1 and Set 2 in order to construct our A-round pillow.
- For Set 1 take two $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric B, one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric A, two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric E and one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric F.
- For Set 1 attach the strips in the following order BAFEBE.
- Repeat Set 1 two times.


DIAGRAM 7

- For Set 2 take two $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips from fabric $F$, two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric E, one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric A and one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric B.
- For Set 2 attach the strips in the following order FEBAFE.
- Repeat Set 2 two times.


DIAGRAM 7

- Take one Set 1, one Grid Set and one $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips from fabric F.
- Attach them together refering to the diagram below
- Repeat one more time.


DIAGRAM 8

- Take one Set 2, one Grid Set and one $4112 " \times$ WOF strips from fabric $F$.
- Attach them together refering to the diagram below
- Repeat one more time.


DIAGRAM 9

- Cut eight Fractional templates from each combination.


DIAGRAM 10

- Attach the sixteen fractional template pieces alternating their order


DIAGRAM 11

- Using Steam-A-Seam Applique the circle template from fabric C on the center.


DIAGRAM 12

- Echo quilt inside the center circle to make reverse applique to reveal the printed fabrics underneath the circle.
- Make sure to cut just where there are see through printed fabrics.


DIAGRAM 13

- Trim the pillow to $241 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ refering to the diagram below.


DIAGRAM 13

- Use fabric G to create piping if desire.


## CREATING THE PILLOW BACK

## Sew rights sides together

- To make a envelope back for your pillow take both rectangles from fabric $C$ and fold one $24^{1} / 2$ " side on each rectangle in $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and press and then fold another $1 / 2$ " and press.
- Top stitch as close to the edge as possible.
- Place rectangles right side together on top of each other to the front of your pillow and stitch all the way around your pillow at $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
- Clip corners at seam allowance and flip piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill pillow with a 24 " $\times 24$ " pillow form and enjoy!

Please read instructions carefully before starting the construction of this quilt. If desired, wash and iron your fabrics before starting to cut.
