## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

One (1) $3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric A.
Two (2) $1 \frac{114 "}{}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric $B$.
Four (4) Kite \#3 Template B from fabric B.
One (1) $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric $C$.
One (1) $101 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ square from fabric $C$.
One (1) $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from fabric $D$.
One (1) $12^{1 ⁄ 2} 2$ square from fabric $E$.
One (1) Kite \#3 Sun template from fabric E.
One (1) Kite \#2 flower template from fabric F.
Kite \#4 Flower Template from fabric F.
One (1) Kite \#2 flower template from fabric G.

One (1) Kite \#3 Sun template from fabric G.

One (1) Kite \#2 flower template from fabric H.
One (1) Kite \#3 Sun template from fabric H.
One (1) Kite \#2 flower template from fabric I.
One (1) Kite \#2 flower template from fabric J.
One (1) Kite \#3 Sun template from fabric J.
Kite \#4 Flower Template from fabric J.
One (1) Kite \#3 Sun template from fabric K.
One (1) 10" square from fabric $L$.
Kite \#4 Flower Template from fabric M.

## CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

- Start constructing Kite \#1.
- Take all the strips from fabrics A-D.
- Attach the strips in the following order BDCBA.


DIAGRAM 1

- Take the Kite \#1 Template and cut four triangles.
- Triangletop pointing up.


DIAGRAM 2

- Place the triangles as shown in the diagram below and star attaching them by pairs.


DIAGRAM 3

- Finish Attaching all the pieces together to create a block.


DIAGRAM 4

- For the contructions of the following kites use Steam-A-Seam to applique their corresponding template on their background square.
- For Kite \#2 applique the flower template on top of the $12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from fabric $E$.


DIAGRAM 5

- For Kite \#3 applique the Sun template on top of the $101 / 2$ " square from fabric C.


DIAGRAM 6

- For Kite \#4 applique the flower template on top of the 10 " square from fabric $L$.
