FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric A	MEW-36305	1 1/8 yd.
Fabric B	MEW-36306	1 yd.
Fabric C	MEW-46302	2 yd.
Fabric D	MEW-46303	1/2 yd.
Fabric E	MEW-46306	1 1/2 yd.
Fabric F	DEN-OYD-6001	1 1/4 yd.
Fabric G	DEN-L-4000	1/2 yd.
Fabric H	PE-420	1/2 yd.

BACKING FABRIC
MEW-46301 - 4 yds. *(suggested)*

BINDING FABRIC
Fabric F DEN-OYD-6001 *included*

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Sew all rights sides together with 1/4" seam allowance.

- Seventy-two (72) 3 1/2" squares from fabrics A and F.
- Thirty-six (36) 4" squares from fabrics A, D and F.
- Seventy-two (72) 4" squares from fabric B.
- Thirty-six (36) 7 1/2" squares from fabric C.
- Nine (9) 7 1/2" squares from fabric E.
- Eighteen (18) 8 1/4" squares from fabric E.
- Nine (9) 8 1/4" squares from fabrics G and H.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with 1/4" seam allowance.

- You are going to make twenty 21" of the following inblock in order to complete this quilt top.



- To construct one block start taking four 4" squares from fabric D and one 7 1/2" square from fabric E.




DIAGRAM 1

- Place the 7 1/2" square from fabric E facing you and start placing the 4" squares from fabric D one by one facing right sides of fabric together.
- Align the fabric D squares to each of the fabric E square corners.
- Make a diagonal seam on top of each fabric D Square.




DIAGRAM 2

- Trim the corners down, make sure you leave a 1/4" seam allowance from the seam.
- Press open and set aside.
