## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.
Fabric A

- Cut Four (4) $2^{1121} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
- Cut Four (4) $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{112 / 2}$ squares.

Fabric B

- Cut Four ( 4 ) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric C

- Cut One (1) $5^{1 ⁄ 24} \times 5^{1 / 1 / 4}$ " square.

Fabric D

- Cut One (1) 4 " $\times 4$ " squares.

Fabric E

- Cut One (1) 4 " $\times 4$ " squares.

Fabric F

- Cut Eight (8) Template 2.

Fabric G

- Cut Four (4) Template 1.

Fabric H

- Cut Four (4) Template 1

Fabric 1

- Cut One (1) $4^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{11 / 2 "}$ square.


## CONSTRUCTION

Sex all rights sides together with $1 / 4$ "seam allowance.

We will be using two different methods for this Block, four at the time HST, and four at the time Flying geese.

## Four at the time HST

- $\quad$ Star by placing one 4" Square from fabric $D$ and $E$ right sides together.
- Sew at $1 / 4$ "around the square.
- Mark a diagonal line across on the wrong side of the fabric square.
- Using your rotary blade, cut the square in quarters following the drawn diagonal lines.
- Press each HST and trim to a $2^{11 / 2} \times 2^{112} 2$ Squares.
- See Diagram 1 for reference.



## Four at the time Flying Geese

- Star by placing one $27 / 8$ Square from fabric B on each opposite corner of a $5^{1 / 4} \times 5^{1 / 1 / 4}$ square from fabric C.
- Draw a line diagonally and stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the line. Cut through the line.
- Now place another $27 / 8$ Square from fabric B and place it on the right bottom corner; draw a diagonal line $1 / 4$ " on each side of the line. Cut through the line, press open, repeat the same step with the other piece.



## Block construction

- For fabric placement and attachment follow diagram 3

- Sew rows together


Block 1


- Repeat the same step with the other blocks
