CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Cord or twine.

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

One (1) $25\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" strip from fabrics A and B.

One (1) Template from fabrics A and B.

Two (2) 6½" x 3" rectangles from fabric C.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

- Take the 25 ½" x 11" strip from fabric A for the basket exterior, place batting to the wrong side of fabric and quilt as desire, then fold it in half.
- Sew the long edges together to create a cylinder.



DIAGRAM 1

- Bring the bottom template from fabric **B** and align the seam with the pattern notch, wrong side of fabrics facing you.
- Pin the cylinder all the way around the pattern.
- Sew all the way around, when you are done make tiny cuts to the round side in order to allow the basket bottom to fit smoothly.
- Turn the basket inside out.
- Set aside.




DIAGRAM 2

- Now, bring the 25 ½" x 11" strip and bottom Template from fabric B for the lining and iron the interfacing.
- Repeat the steps from diagram two with the fabric B lining but this time leave an opening of about 3" in the lining bottom to be able to turn it inside out later on.




DIAGRAM 3

- Now, that the exterior basket and lining are ready, insert the exterior (A basket) inside of the lining (B basket) right sides of fabrics together, align and secure it with pins.
- Sew all the way around.





DIAGRAM 4

- Use the 3" opening to turn the basket inside out and handstitch to close it.
- Top stitch the basket.







DIAGRAM 6

- Bring the long edges towards the center line and Iron press.
- Fold them in half and Iron press again.
- Top stitch the long sides.

- Fold the strap, and align it to the flat top edge of the basket.
- Pin the straps in place and sew them 1/4" away from the edge.





DIAGRAM 8

- Fold the straps towards the opening and iron press.
- Top stitch the straps to hold them in place.




DIAGRAM 9

- Insert the dowel stick inside the straps.
- Define your decided hanging lenght and tie the twine to each side of the stick.
