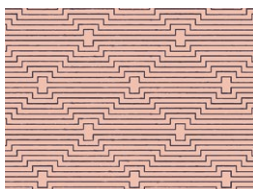

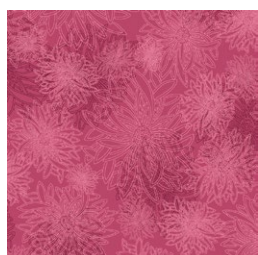

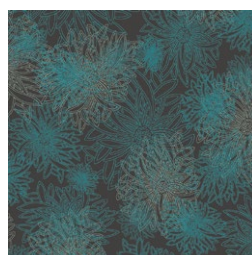

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

*¼" seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.*

Fabric **A**

- (4) 18½" x 2" strips.
- (2) 24½" x 17½" rectangles.

Fabric **B**

- (4) 18½" x 2½" strips.

Fabric **C**

- (4) 18½" x 2" strips.

Fabric **D**

- (4) 18½" x 1½" strips.

Fabric **E**

- (4) 18½" x 2½" strips.

Fabric **F**

- (4) 18½" x 2½" strips.
- (4) 18½" x 1½" strips.

Fabric **G**

- (4) 18½" x 2½" strips.

Fabric **H**

- (4) 18½" x 1½" strips.

- (4) 18½" x 2½" strips.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

- Arrange the strips as shown on diagram 1.
- Repeat this step 3 more times.

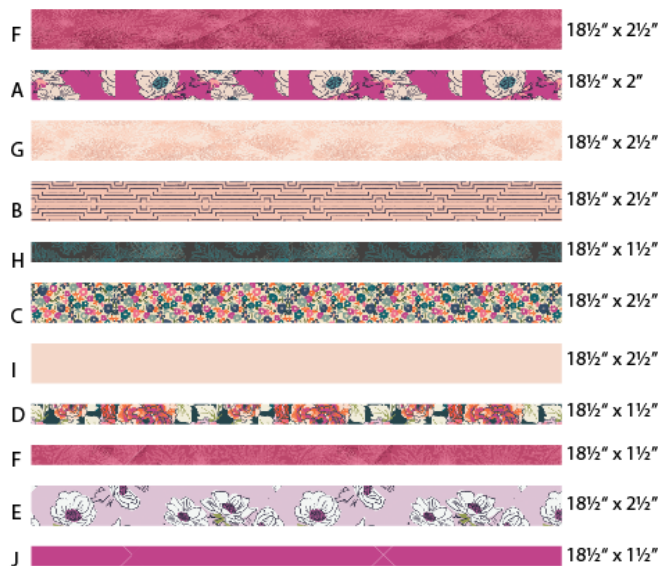


DIAGRAM 1

- Create (1) $12\frac{1}{2}"$ square template using cardboard, and place it on point, on top of the strip block.
- Cut the block tracing the pattern. Repeat the same step 3 more times
- See diagram 2 for reference

DIAGRAM 2

- Arrange blocks in two rows of two blocks each, and sew rows together.

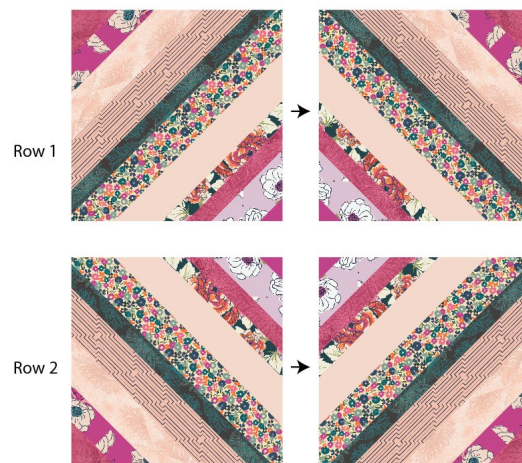


DIAGRAM 3

DIAGRAM 4

BACK OF THE PILLOW

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance.

- Take both 24½" x 17½" rectangles from fabric A.
- Fold one 17½" edge ½" towards the wrong side of the fabric of each rectangle.
- Fold the same edge ½" again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric A and align it wrong side up to the right side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric A and align it wrong side up to the left side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at ¼".
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a 24" x 24" pillow form and enjoy!
