## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

- Two (2) $3^{1 ⁄ 2}$ " squares from fabric $A$
- Two (2) $4^{11 / 2 "} \times 3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles from fabric A
- Two (2) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles from fabric $A$
- Two (2) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{112 "}$ " rectangles from fabric $A$
- One (1) $61 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square from fabric B
- Two (2) $3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares from Fabric C


## CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

- Take (2) $4^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 3^{11 / 2 "}$ rectangles from fabric A and (2) $3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares from fabric $C$.
- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of fabric C square.
- Place one fabric C square on the right side of fabric A rectangle, right sides facing.
- Sew on the diagonal and trim excess fabric leaving $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
- Press seam open.


DIAGRAM 1

- Repeat the same process, but this time placing fabric C square on the left side of fabric A rectangle.

- Take (2) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles from fabric $A$ and join one on the right side of one of the assembled unit, and one on the left side, following the diagram below.

- Take (1) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from fabric B and (2) $3^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares from fabric $A$.
- Place one $3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on the top right corner of fabric $B$ square, right sides facing.
- Place the second square on the oposite corner.
- Sew at the diagonal, trimming excess fabric and leaving $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
- Press seam open.


DIAGRAM 4

- Take (2) $61 / 2 " \times 3^{11 / 2 "}$ rectangles from fabric A and join one on each side of the $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ block.

- To complete your block, join all three rows, following the diagram below.
