

 Fabric E
 PE-457
 ½ yd.

 Fabric F
 PE-460
 ½ yd.

BACKING FABRIC

SNS-13007 2 yds (Suggested)

### CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

• Three (3) 4" x WOF strips from fabrics A-F.

## CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

- Two strip sets need to be made for the rug construction.
- Start with Set #1.

#### SET #1

- Take one 4" strip from fabrics A, B and C.
- Attach them in the order BAC.
- Press.
- Repeat Set #1 two more times for a total of three.




DIAGRAM 1

- Now, bring the template and place it on top of Set #1, align it to center.
- Cut fifteen templates from each sewn Set #1 alternating directions, start from left to right, first template pointing down.
- Eight pointing down, seven pointing up.
- Refer to diagram below for template placement.




DIAGRAM 2

- You'll end up with two different patches named Set #1a and Set#1b.
- You will need the following quantities for the rug construction from each set.

DIAGRAM 3

#### SET#2

- Take one 4" strip from fabrics D, E and F.
- Attach then in the order DFE.
- Press.
- Repeat Set #2 two more times for a total of three.




DIAGRAM 4

- Now, bring the template and place it on top of Set #2, align it to center.
- Cut fifteen templates from each sewn Set #2 alternating directions, start from left to right, first template pointing down.
- Eight pointing down, seven pointing up.
- Refer to diagram below for template placement.




DIAGRAM 5

- You'll end up with two different patches named Set #2a and Set #2b.
- You will need the following quantities for the rug construction from each set.






DIAGRAM 6

- Take seven SET #1a pieces and six SET #2b pieces.
- Attach them as shown in the diagram below alternating their order.
- Press.
- Repeat it two more times to end up with a total of three.
- Press and set aside.




DIAGRAM 7

- Take seven SET #2a pieces and six SET #1b pieces.
- Attach them as shown in the diagram below alternating their order.
- Press.
- Repeat it two more times to end up with a total of three.
- Press.



DIAGRAM 7

- Take the sewn pieces in diagrams 6 & 7.
- Attach them together.
- Refer to the diagram below for alignment.
- Press.
- Repeat it with all the pieces, three total.



• Bring all the sew pieces and attach them together refering to the diagram below.




DIAGRAM 9

• Use your clear ruler and the rotary cutter to trim it to  $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $64\frac{1}{2}$ ."



DIAGRAM 10

• Add batting and quilt as desired.



- Place the backing fabric on top, facing right side of fabrics together and sew all the way around the rug leaving an opening of about 5" to turn it inside out.
- Hand stitch the opening and press.
- It is recommended to hand sew a few circles of shelf liner to the bottom of the rug in order to prevent slipperiness.
- Voila! your rug is done.
