### ADDITIONAL BLENDERS FOR THIS PROJECT



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• Rotate your piece at a 45 degree angle, and cut a 16  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 16  $\frac{1}{2}$  square

#### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

 Fabric A
 FUS-AD-1609
 1¼4yd.

 Fabric B
 PE-473
 ¼4yd.

 Fabric C
 PE-461
 ¼6yd.

BACKING FABRIC Fabric A FUS-AD-1609 -(Included)

#### CUTTING DIRECTIONS

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

- Eight (8) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 26 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips from fabric A
- Four (4) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 26 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips from fabric B
- Three (3) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 26 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips from fabric C

#### CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

• Join the following strips together





#### CREATING THE BACK PILLOW

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance. Press open.

- Take both  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13" rectangles from fabric A.
- Fold one 13" edge ½" towards the wrong side of the fabric of each rectangle.
- Fold the same edge ½" again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric **A** and align it wrong side up to the right side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric **A** and align it wrong side up to the left side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>".
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a 16" x 16" pillow form and enjoy!
