FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric A	PE-435	¹⁄₄ yd.
Fabric B	PE-471	¹⁄₄ yd.
Fabric C	DDR-25446	¹⁄₄ yd.
Fabric D	DDR-25447	¹⁄₄ yd.
Fabric E	PE-433	¹⁄₄ yd.
Fabric F	DDR-25441	Fat 8.
Fabric G	PE-403	⁵% yd.
BACKING FABRIC PE-403 (included)		

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

¼" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric. RSF means right side of fabric.

- Eight (8) 3½" squares from fabrics A & E.
- Four (4) 4" squares from fabric A.
- Eight (8) 4" squares from fabrics B & E.
- Four (4) 7½" squares from fabric C.
- Two (2) $8\frac{1}{4}$ " squares from fabric **D**.
- One (1) $7\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabric **D**.
- One (1) 8 1/4" squares from fabrics F & G.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

- Star with the construction of the center block.
- Take four 4" squares from fabric **E** and one 7½" square from fabric **D**.



DIAGRAM 1

- Place the 7½" square from fabric D RSF facing you and start laying on top the 4" squares from fabric E one by one RSF together.
- Take one fabric E squares and align it to the top right corner of the fabric D square.
- Make a diagonal seam on top of fabric E square as shown in the diagram below.
- Trim excess fabric, 1/4" away from the seam and press open and set aside.
- Repeat the previous steps with the fabric E squares for all the fabric D square corners.




DIAGRAM 2

- Continue with the construction of the corner blocks.
- Take one 4" square from fabrics A & E, two 4" square from fabric B and one 7½" square from fabric C.



DIAGRAM 3

 Repeat the previous steps made for the center block but this time refer to the diagram below for fabrics placement and combination.




DIAGRAM 4

- There are two hourglass blocks combinations need for this pillow, start with HGB combination one.
- Take one 81/4" square from fabrics D and F.
- Make a HST using the two squares.
- Sub-cut the **DF** HST diagonally and set aside.




DIAGRAM 5

- Continue with HGB combination two.
- Take one 81/4" square from fabrics D and G.
- Make a HST using the two squares.
- Sub-cut the DG HST diagonally and set aside.




DIAGRAM 6

- Now bring one DG half square and one DF half square.
- Attach them together.
- Press open and set aside.
- Make a total of four.

DIAGRAM 7

• Take two 3½" from fabrics A and E.



DIAGRAM 8

- Attach one A & E squares together, then the other two E & A.
- Attach AE and EA together




DIAGRAM 9

- Place the template on top of the previous made piece.
- Align the cross in the star template to the seams and cut it.
- Make a total of four.





DIAGRAM 10



- Bring the hour glass blocks previously made and place the template star on top of it.
- Align it to center and using Steam-A-Seam applique on top.
- Top stitch if desire to hold it in place or make sure to stitch on top when quilting.

DIAGRAM 11

- Take all the previous made pieces and follow the diagram below for blocks placement.
- Make three rows with three blocks each and attach the rows together.
- Quilt as desired.






DIAGRAM 12

PILLOW BACKING

Sew rights sides together.

- Take two 21 ½" x 15 ½" rectangles from your chosen backing fabric.
- Fold one 21 ½" edge ½" towards the wrong side of the fabric of each rectangle.
- Fold the same edge ½" again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle for backing fabric and align it wrong side up to the right side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle for backing and align it wrong side up to the left side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at 1/4".
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a 21" x 21" pillow form and enjoy!
