CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

Placemat 1:

- One (1) 11/2" x WOF strip from fabric A.
- Five (5) 1½" squares from fabric A.
- One (1) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B**.
- One (1) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B**.

- One (1) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric B.
- One (1) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B**.
- One (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric B.
- One (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric B.
- One (1) 2½" x 1½" rectangle from fabric B.
- Four (4) 1½" squares from fabric B.
- One (1) 11/2" x WOF strip from fabric C.
- One (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip from fabric **D**.
- Four (4) 1½" squares from fabric D.
- One (1) 11/2" x WOF strip from fabric E.

Placemat 2:

- One (1) 1½" x WOF strip from fabric A.
- Five (5) 11/2" squares from fabric A.
- One (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip from fabric **B**.
- One (1) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B**.
- One (1) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B**.
- One (1) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric B.
- One (1) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B**.
- One (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B**.
- One (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B**.
- One (1) 2½" x 1½" rectangle from fabric B.
- Eight (8) 1½" squares from fabric B.
- One (1) 1½" x WOF strip from fabric C.
- One (1) 1½" x WOF strip from fabric D.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

Placemat 1

- We will work with strip sets.
- Take the 1½" x WOF strip from fabrics A,C.





DIAGRAM 1

- Cut twelve 1½" strips this will be the Strip Set AC.
- Set aside the rest the leftover fabric.



- Take the 1½" x WOF strip from fabrics D, E.
- Set aside the leftover fabric.



Cut four (4) 1 1/2" strips this will be Strip Set DE

Strip Set 1:

 Join one AC strip set with one 1½" square from fabric A (repeat this step one more time).



Strip Set 2:

 Join two AC strip sets, one on top and one on the bottom of one 1½" square from fabric D (repeat this step one more time)



Strip Set 3:

- Take one DE strip set and join it with one 1½" square from fabric D.
- Then, take two AC strip sets and join one on the top and one on the bottomw of the DED strip, following the diagram below (repeat this step one more time).







Strip Set 4:

- Take two AC strip sets, two DE strip sets and one 1½" square from fabric A.
- Join the pieces following the diagram below.



• Take four 4½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric **B**, four 3½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric **B**, four 2½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric **B** and four 1½" squares from fabric **B** and your strip sets and join each column following the diagram below.



• Join columns 1-9 and your strip sets and join each column following the diagram below.



• Now, join one $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strip from fabric **B** on the left side of the block.



• Then, join one 10½" x 1½" strip from fabric **B** on the top and one 10½" x 2½" strip from fabric **B** on the bottom part of the block.



Finish your place mat by joining one 12½" x 5½" rectangle from fabric B on the right side of the assembled piece.



- Take the 1½" x WOF strip from fabrics A,C.





- Cut twelve 1½" strips this will be the Strip Set AC.

 Join one AC strip set with one 1½" square from fabric A (repeat this step one more time).



Strip Set 2:

 Join two AC strip sets, one on top and one on the bottom of one 1½" square from fabric B (repeat this step one more time)



Strip Set 3:

 Take one BD strip set and join it with one 1½" square from fabric B.

 Then, take two AC strip sets and join one on the top and one on the bottomw of the BDB strip, following the diagram below (repeat this step one more time).



Strip Set 4:

- Take two AC strip sets, two BD strip sets and one 1½" square from fabric A.
- Join the pieces following the diagram below.



• Take four 4½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric B, four 3½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric B, four 2½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric B and four 1½" squares from fabric B and your strip sets and join each column following the diagram below.



• Join columns 1-9 and your strip sets and join each column following the diagram below.



• Now, join one 9½" x 1½" strip from fabric **B** on the left side of the block.



• Then, join one 10½" x 1½" strip from fabric **B** on the top and one 10½" x 2½" strip from fabric **B** on the bottom part of the block.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

Sew rights sides together.


- Place BACKING FABRIC on a large surface wrong side up. Stretch it with masking tape against that surface.
- Place BATTING on top of backing fabric.
- Place TOP on top of the batting with right side facing up. Smooth away wrinkles using your hands.
- Pin all layers together and baste with basting thread, using long stitches. You can also use safety pins to join the layers.
- Machine or hand quilt starting at the center and working towards the corners. Remember that quilting motifs are a matter of personal preference. Have fun choosing yours!
- After you finished, trim excess of any fabric or batting, squaring the quilt to proceed to bind it.

BINDING

Sew rights sides together.

- Cut enough strips 1½" wide by the width of the fabrics **B** and **D** to make the final strips of 64" long each. Set aside one on the binding strips. Fold strip in half and press. Start sewing the binding strip in the middle of one of the sides of the quilt, placing the strip right side down with the fold edge of your binding facing in and leaving an approximated 5" tail. Sew with ½" seam allowance (using straight stitch), aligning the strip's raw edge with the placemat top's raw edge.
- Stop stitching ¼" before the edge of the placemat (DIAGRAM B 1). Clip the threads. Remove the quilt from under the machine presser foot. Fold the strip in a motion of 45° and upward, pressing with your fingers (DIAGRAM B2). Hold this fold with your finger, bring the strip down in line with the next edge, making a horizontal fold that aligns with the top edge of the quilt (DIAGRAM B3). Start sewing at ¼" of the border, stitching all the layers. Do the same in the four corners of the placemat.

- Stop stitching before you reach the last 5 or 6 inches. Cut the threads and remove the placemat from under the machine presser foot. Lay the loose ends of the binding flat along the quilt edge, folding the ends back on themselves where they meet. Press them together to form a crease. Using this crease as the stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding with right sides together (you can help yourself marking with a pencil if the crease is difficult to see).
- Trim seam to ½" and press open. Complete the sewing. Turn binding to back of the placemat, turn raw edge inside and stitch by hand using blind stitch.
- Repeat the same process for the second placemat.
