FABRIC REQUIREMENTS



CUTTING DIRECTIONS

¹/₄" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

Basket 1 & Basket 2

- One (1) $4^{\frac{1}{2}}$ square from fabric A.
- One (1) 16¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" strip from fabric A.
- One (1) 4¹/₂" square from fabric **B**.
- One (1) 16¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" strip from fabric **B**.
- One (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square from fabric interfacing.
- One (1) $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip from interfacing.

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- One (1) $4^{\frac{1}{2}}$ square from fabric batting.
- One (1) 16¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" strip from batting.

Basket 3

- One (1) $4^{\frac{1}{2}} \times 8^{\frac{1}{2}}$ rectangle from fabric A.
- One (1) 25" x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip from fabric A.
- One (1) $4^{1/2}$ " x $8^{1/2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B**.
- One (1) 25" x 4¹/₂" strip from fabric **B**.
- One (1) 4¹/₂" x 8¹/₂" rectangle from fabric interfacing.
- One (1) 25" x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip from interfacing.
- One (1) 4¹/₂" x 8¹/₂" rectangle square from fabric batting.
- One (1) 25" x $4^{1/2}$ " strip from batting.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

EXTERIOR FABRIC

- Take one (1) 16¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" strip from fabric A and batting.
- Place the wrong side of fabric **A** aligned on top of the batting strip.
- Quilt if desired or sew ¼" on the top and bottom edge to hold everything together.





DIAGRAM 1

• Fold it in half, right sides of fabrics together, sew the short edges together.



- Bring one (1) 4¹/₂" square from fabric A and batting.
- Place the wrong side of fabric A aligned on top of the batting strip.
- Sew ¹/₄" on the top and bottom edge to hold everything together.



DIAGRAM 3

- Bring both exterior pieces and pin the strip all the way around the square, batting facing you.
- Sew all the way around.
- Set aside.



DIAGRAM 4

LINING FABRIC

- Take one 16½" x 4½" strips from fabric ${\bf B}$ and interfacing.
- Align and iron the interfacing on the wrong side of the fabric.



DIAGRAM 5

• Take the 16¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" strip and fold it in half right sides of fabrics together, sew the short edges together.



- Bring the 4½" square from fabric **B** and interfacing.
- Align and iron the interfacing on the wrong side of the fabric.

DIAGRAM 7

- Bring both lining pieces and pin the strip all the way around the square, interfacing side facing you.
- Sew around the square but this time make sure to leave an opening big enough to turn the basket inside out later on.

• Repeat the previous steps from basket 1 for baskets 2 & 3.

• Now that your exterior and lining pieces are ready, it's time to put the basket together.





DIAGRAM 9

- Insert the exterior basket inside of the lining basket right sides of fabrics together, align and secure it with pins.
- Sew all the way around.



DIAGRAM 10

- Use the lining opening to turn the basket inside out and handstitch it to close it.
- Top stitch the basket and hand stitch the opening.
