## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

- One (1) $53 / 4$ " square from fabric $A$.
- One (1) $5^{3 / 4}$ " square from fabric B.
- One (1) 5 3/4" square from fabric C.
- One (1) $5^{3 / 4}$ " square from fabric $D$.
- One (1) $53 / 4$ " square from fabric $E$.
- One (1) $27 / 8 "$ square from fabric $E$.
- One (1) 5 ³/4" square from fabric F.
- One (1) $5^{3 / 4}$ " square from fabric $G$.
- One (1) $53 / 4$ " square from fabric $H$.
- One (1) 53/4" square from fabric I.
- One (1) $5^{3 / 4}$ " square from fabric J.
- Ten (10) 53/4" squares from fabric K.
- One (1) $27 / 8^{" 1}$ square from fabric K.
- Two (2) $18^{1 / 2}$ " $\times 14^{1 / 2}$ " rectangles from fabric K.


## CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with 1/1/seam allowance.

- Take one (1) 5 ³/4" square from fabrics A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I and J, and ten (10) $5^{3 / 4}$ " squares from fabric $K$.
- Pair every $5^{3 / 4}$ " square from fabrics A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I and $J$ with one $5^{3 / 4}$ " square from fabric $K$ and do the 8 at a time HST:

- Take one (1) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square from fabrics E and K and follow the diagram to get two HST, you will only need one.

- For the pillow top you will need the following HST:

- Arrange the HST into rows:

Row 1: G-H-I-J-A-B-C-D-E
Row 2: H-I-J-A-B-C-D-E-F
Row 3: I-J-A-B-C-D-E-F-G
Row 4: J-A-B-C-D-E-F-G-H
Row 5: A-B-C-D-E-F-G-H-I
Row 6: B-C-D-E-F-G-H-I-J
Row 7: C-D-E-F-G-H-I-J-A
Row 8: D-E-F-G-H-I-J-A - B
Row 9: E-F-G-H-I-J-A-B-C


## QUILTING ASSEMBLY

Sew rights sides together.

- Place BACKING FABRIC on a large surface wrong side up. Stretch it with masking tape against that surface.
- Place BATTING on top of backing fabric.
- Place TOP on top of the batting with right side facing up. Smooth away wrinkles using your hands.
- Pin all layers together and baste with basting thread, using long stitches. You can also use safety pins to join the layers.
- Machine or hand quilt starting at the center and working towards the corners. Remember that quilting motifs are a matter of personal preference. Have fun choosing yours!
- After you finished, trim excess of any fabric or batting, squaring the pillow top.


## BACK OF THE PILLOW

Sew rights sides together.

- Take both $18^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles from fabric K.
- Fold one $18^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ edge $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ towards the wrong side of the fabric of each rectangle.
- Fold the same edge $1 / 2$ " again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric K and align it wrong side up to the top side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric K and align it wrong side up to the bottom side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at $1 / 4$.
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a 18 " $\times 18^{\prime \prime}$ pillow form and enjoy!
