## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

| Fabric A | FUS-BL-1800 | $3 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$. |

| Fabric B | CAP-SV-11600 | $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$. |
| Fabric C | CAP-SV-11601 | $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$. |
| Fabric D | CAP-SV-11606 | $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$. |
| Fabric E | DEN-L-4000 | $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$. |
| Fabric F | DEN-S-2006 | $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$. |

BACKING FABRIC
FUS-BL-1800 (Included)

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

Fabric A

- Eight (8) $161 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Two (2) $17^{1 ⁄ 2 "} \times 161 / 2 "$ rectangles.

Fabric B

- Four (4) 4½" squares.
- Two (2) $161 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric C

- Two (2) $1^{1 ⁄ 2 "} \times$ WOF strips.
- Two (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips.

Fabric

- Two (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips.

Fabric E

- Two (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips.
- Sixteen (16) $2^{1 ⁄ 21} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric F

- Two (2) $1^{1 ⁄ 2 "} \times$ WOF strips.
- Two (2) $161 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{112} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.


## CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

## Center Blocks:

- Start by placing one (1) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from fabric E at the top left corner of a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from fabric $B$.
- Sew diagonally, trim ¼" away from seam allowance and press open.
- Place another $2^{11 / 2 "}$ square from fabric E to the top right corner of the same $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from fabric $B$, sew diagonally, trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from seam allowance and press open.
- Keep repeating the same steps with the other two (2) $2^{112} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares from fabric E at the two bottom corners of the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from fabric B.


- Sew the four (4) center blocks together.

## Strip Blocks:

- Join one (1) $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip from fabrics C, E, F, D, and one (1) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip from fabric C.
- Repeat this step one more time.

- Create a $4^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square cardboard template, place it on top of the strip set previously made by aligning the side corners of the template in between fabric F and D seam, and cut, following the edges of the template.
- Repeat this step to get a total of eight (8) strip blocks.
- Sew the four (4) strip blocks together by alternating their direction.
- See diagram below for reference.
- Repeat this step one more time.


DIAGRAM 5

- Join two (2) $16^{1 / 2 "} \times 1^{11 / 2 "}$ strips from fabric A and one (1) $16^{1 / 2} \times 1^{1 / 2} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from fabric $B$ as shown on diagram below.
- Repeat this step one more time.


DIAGRAM 6

- Join two (2) $166^{1 / 2 "} \times 1^{11 / 2 "}$ strips from fabric A and one (1) $161^{1 / 2} \times 1^{\prime 1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from fabric F as shown on diagram below.
- Repeat this step one more time.

- Arrange pieces as shown on diagram below.

## BACK OF THE PILLOW

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

- Take both $171_{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16 "$ rectangles from fabric $A$.
- Fold on the top edge $1 / 2$ " towards the wrong side of the fabric of one of the rectangle.
- Fold the same edge $1 / 2$ " again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Repeat the same but this time on the top edge of the other piece.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric C and align it wrong side up to the right side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric C and align it wrong side up to the left side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a $24^{\prime \prime} \times 16$ " pillow form and enjoy!
