## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

- Sixty four (64) 1 1/2" squares from fabric A.
- Sixteen (16) $3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares from fabric $A$.
- Two (2) $12^{11 / 2 "} \times 3^{1 / 2 "}$ " strips from fabric A.
- Two (2) $181 / 2$ " $\times 1^{112 "}$ strips from fabric A.
- Four (4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles from fabric A.
- Two (2) $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1} 122^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles from fabric B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, L, M, O, P.
- One (1) $61 / 2 " \times 3^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles from fabric D, J, M, N.


## CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

## Flying Geese Construction:

- Place a $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from fabric $A$ to the right edge of a $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle from fabric $G$ mark a diagonal line from the top left corner to the bottom right corner of fabric A square, sew through the line, trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the stitch line and press.
- Take another $11 / 2$ " square from fabric A and place it to the left edge of the sewn piece, mark a diagonal line from the bottom left corner to the top right corner of fabric A square, sew through the line and trim $1 / 4$ " away from the stitch line, and press.
- Repeat this step one more time to get a total of two (2) AGA flying geese.

- Repeat the flying geese method to get the following combinations using $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabric $A$ for all $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle from fabrics B, C, D, E, F, H, I, J, K, L, $\mathrm{M}, \mathrm{O}, \mathrm{P}$.


DIAGRAM 2

- Repeat the flying geese method to get the following combinations with eight (8) $3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares from fabric A and one (1) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangle from fabrics D, M, N and $J$.


DIAGRAM 3

- Sew all $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1 / 2 "}$ flying geese by columns and add one (1) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle from fabric A to the top and bottom of each column.
- For fabric placement and attachment follow diagram 4.

DIAGRAM 4

- Join one (1) $3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from fabric $A$ to each side of ADA flying geese.
- Repeat the same step for AMA, ANA, and AJA.
- Sew rows together.


DIAGRAM 5

- Join one (1) $12^{1 / 2 "} \times 3^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle from fabric A to the top and bottom.

- Sew all columns together.

- Quilt as desired.

## BACK OF THE PILLOW

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

- Take both $18^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 13^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles from fabric A.
- Fold on the top edge $1 / 2$ " towards the wrong side of the fabric of one of the rectangle.
- Fold the same edge $1 / 2$ " again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Repeat the same but this time on the top edge of the other piece.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric A and align it wrong side up to the right side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric A and align it wrong side up to the left side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at $1 / 4$ ".
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a 18 " $\times 18$ " pillow form and enjoy!
