

Fabric B	PE-486	Fat 8.
Fabric C	PE-454	Fat 8.

Fabric A	LLP-56709	½ yd.

Fabric C	PE-454	Fat 8.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

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Cut fabric A on fold in order to have two opposite sides.

- Two (2) Body #1 templates from fabric A.
- Two (2) Arm templates from fabric A.
- Two (2) Tail templates from fabric A.
- Two (2) Right leg templates from fabric A.

• Two (2) Left leg templates from fabric A.



- One (1) Body #2 template from fabric B.
- One (1) ¹/₂" circle from fabric **C**.
- Two (2) Body #1 templates D.
- Two (2) Arm templates D.
- Two (2) Tail templates D.
- Two (2) Right leg templates D.
- Two (2) Left leg templates D.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼ "seam allowance.

- Take the Body #1 template from fabric **A** thats facing right and the Body #2 template from fabric **B**.
- Use Steam-A- Seam to iron the Body #2 template from fabric **B** on top of the Body #1 template and the ½" circle from fabric **C**.
- Stitch around to hold the fabric in place.



DIAGRAM 1

- Use the paper template and a fabric market to trace your guide lines on the fabric.
- Draw the eye using your sewing machine or handstitching.
- Set aside.



DIAGRAM 2

- Take the Tail templates from fabric A.
- Place the templates together facing right sides together and sew leaving and opening as shown in the diagram below.
- Take two Tail pieces from fabric **D** for the pillow case fabric and repeat the same procedure.





DIAGRAM 3

- Turn the fabric **A** tail inside out and press, then insert the case in the fabric **A** Tail template and use some pillow fill.
- Set aside.



DIAGRAM 4

• Repeat the previous steps made for the Tail with the arm, and the right & left legs.



- To construct the pillow case take two (2) Body #1 templates from fabric D fabric, sew the pieces together facing rigth sides of fabrics together.
- Use the paper template stitches to mark where your want to sew and where the openings to insert the legs and the tail should go.
- Sew the pieces together.
- Turn it inside out through the tail opening, which is the biggest one.
- Press.




DIAGRAM 6

- Take the two (2) Body #1 templates from fabric **A** and the arm.
- Stitch the arm on place on top of the front pillow template.
- Then, sew the front and back pieces together except where the legs, and the tail go as you did previously for the pillow case.
- Turn it right side out and press.

- Insert the fabric **D** pillow case through the tail opening, make sure that the pillow case matches the exterior pillow.
- When the pillows are aligned start filling the pillow as desired.

• Insert the tail and legs and top stitch them in place.



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TEMPLATES

1" test square FOX #2 & #3 LEFT LEG TAIL ARM FOX #2 & #3 **RIGHT LEG**
