FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Placemat 1:

Fabric A	DSE-714	$\frac{3}{4}$ yd.
Fabric B	DSE-707	$\frac{1}{8}$ yd.
Fabric C	DSE-720	$\frac{1}{8}$ yd.
Fabric D	DSE-718	$\frac{1}{8}$ yd.
Fabric E	DSE-715	$\frac{1}{8}$ yd.
Fabric F	DSE-700	$\frac{1}{8}$ yd.

Placemat 2:

Fabric A	DSE-704	$\frac{3}{4}$ yd.
Fabric B	DSE-714	$\frac{1}{8}$ yd.
Fabric C	DSE-722	$\frac{1}{8}$ yd.
Fabric D	DSE-708	$\frac{1}{8}$ yd.
Fabric E	DSE-716	$\frac{1}{8}$ yd.
Fabric F	DSE-717	$\frac{1}{8}$ yd.

BACKING FABRIC

Placemat 1 Fabric **A** DSE-714 *(Included)*

Placemat 2 Fabric **A** DSE-704 *(Included)*

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

$\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.

- Four (4) 18" x 1½" strips from fabric **A**.
- Four (4) triangle template from fabric **A**.
- One (1) 18" x 1" strip from fabric **B, C, D, E, F**.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

- Arrange strips from fabrics **A** to **F** as shown on diagram below and sew together.
- You should have a strip block that measures 18" x 7".

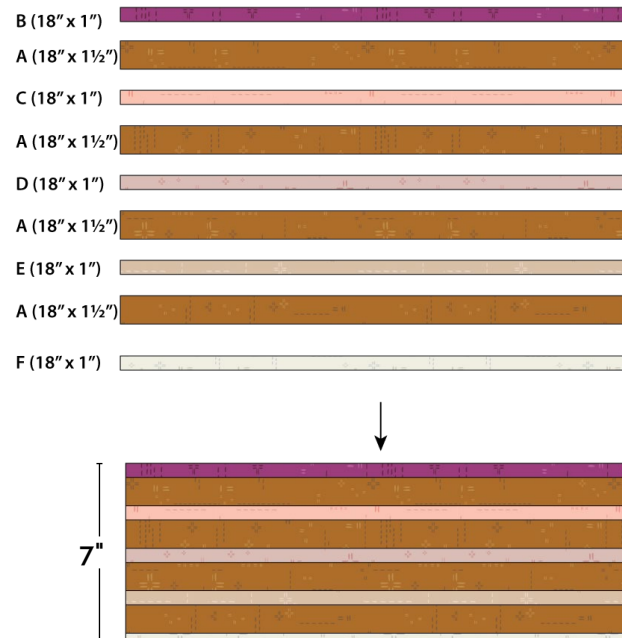


DIAGRAM 1

- Place the triangle template on the strip block and cut by tracing the template.
- You will be able to cut two triangles per strip block.

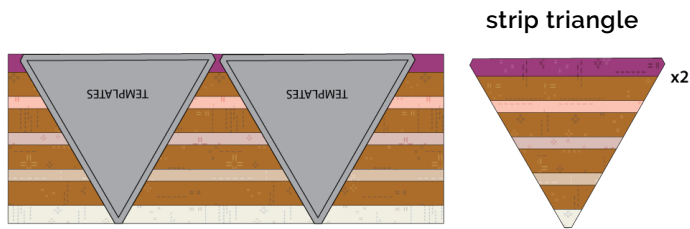


DIAGRAM 2

- Take two (2) strip triangles and four (4) triangles from fabric A arrange them by rows and sew them together.
- Pay attention to the direction of the **strip triangle**.

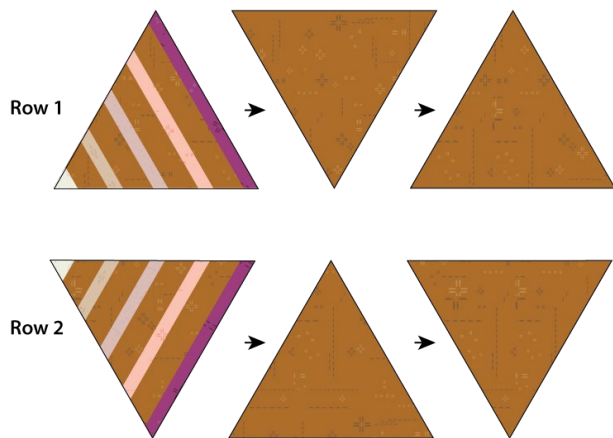


DIAGRAM 3

- Sew the two rows together and that will be the front of the placemat.

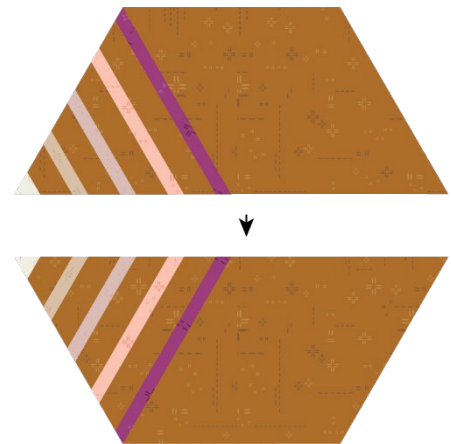


DIAGRAM 4

- Use the front of the placemat as a template to cut the backing of this project.
- Place it on top of fabric A and cut by tracing the shape of the front of the placemat.

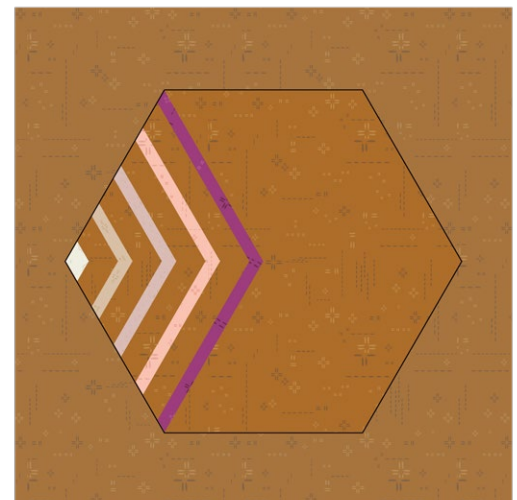

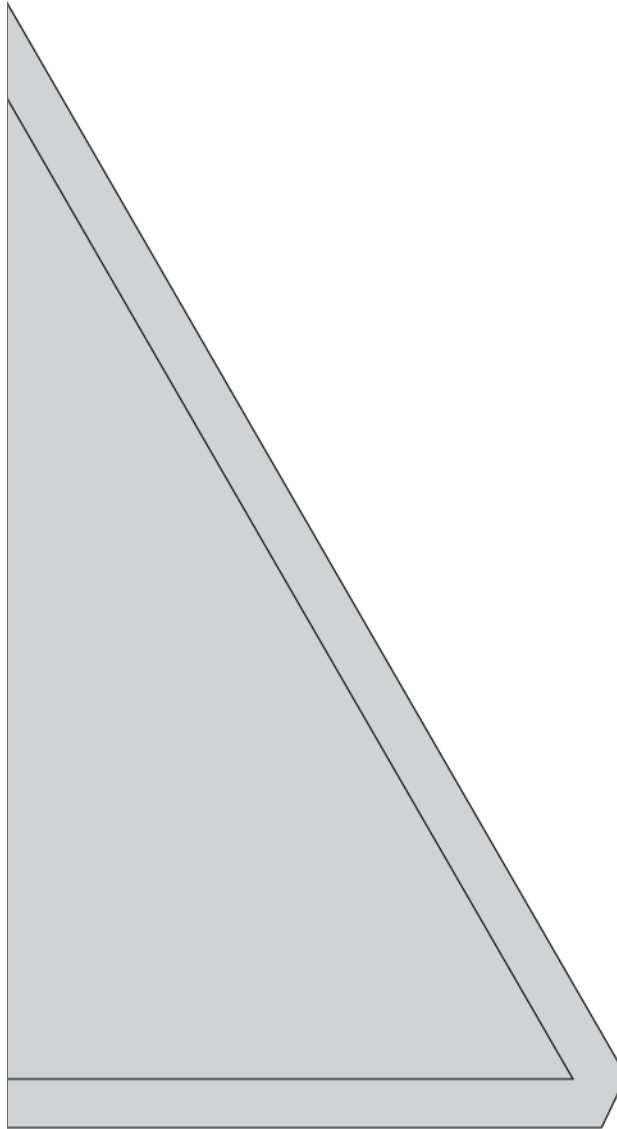



DIAGRAM 4

- Place both hexies facing together, sew all the edges and leave around 3" to 4" opening to turn the placemat right side out.
- Finish by edge stitching the opening.
