FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric **A** DEN-L-4000 F8.
 Fabric **B** DAT-99404 F8.
 Fabric **C** PE-422 Scraps.

LINING FABRIC
 DAT-99404 (Included)

ADDITIONAL MATERIAL

- Steam-a-seam Double side fusible tape
- Neon Green Faux Leather Fabric

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

*¼" seam allowances are included.
 WOF means width of fabric.*

- Two (2) 5½" x 8½" rectangle from fabric **A**.
- Two (2) Sunglass Template from fabric **B**.
- Two (2) 5½" x 8½" rectangle from fabric **B**. (lining)
- Two (2) Lens Template from Neon Green fabric.
- One (1) Bridge Template from fabric **C**.
- Two (2) Decor Template from fabric **C**.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance.

- Take one 5½" x 8½" rectangle piece from fabric **A** and your sunglass pieces.
- Once applied steam a seam on the wrong side of the sunglass template, place it on the rectangle piece.
- Press and steam.
- Now, take the lens template and place it on top of the sunglass template.
- Then, take the bridge template and place it next to the lens and sunglass template.
- Now, repeat the same process for the other sunglass and lens template.
- And last, place the two decor template.
- To secure the sunglass, top stitch with desired color thread.



DIAGRAM 1

- Quilt as desired

ASSEMBLING THE CLUTCH

- Change your sewing foot for the zipper foot.
- Place one (1) 5½" x 8½" rectangle from fabric **A** right side up on your work surface.
- Center the zipper, right side up, on top of the fabric.
- Place your top piece on top of the lining/zipper, right side down.
- You should have lining face up, zipper face up, main face down.
- Stitch along the edge of the zipper.



DIAGRAM 2

- Fold back and press the main fabric and the lining to expose the finished edges along the zipper.



DIAGRAM 3

- Open the zipper and repeat the previous steps for the other side using the backing piece and the other lining piece.



DIAGRAM 4

- Separate the front piece together with the backing and then the lining pieces together on each side of the bag fold the "flaps" so that you are matching the exterior fabrics right sides together, and the lining fabrics right sides together.
- Pin in place to form one large rectangle with exterior pieces to one side and lining pieces to the other side.
- The red line in the picture above shows your stitching line.
- Stitch, with ½" seam allowance, all the way around the clutch, leaving a 4-5 inch opening in the LINING side of the bag for turning.



DIAGRAM 5

- Turn the clutch inside out and handstitch the lining opening.
- Press.
