FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric A	OHW-68689	¾ yd.
Fabric B	OHW-68690	3⁄4 yd.
Fabric C	OHW-68689	⅓ yd.
ADDITIONAL MATERIALS		

Steam A Seam (Suggested)

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

¹/₄" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

- Cut two (2) $9^{1/2}$ " x $1^{1/2}$ " strips from fabrics A.
- Cut one (1) 40" x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabrics A , B.
- Cut one (1) template 1 from fabrics A , B.
- Cut one (1) template 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 from fabric C.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

- Using steam a seam iron press for 20 seconds to activate the fusible web and create a permanent bond between template 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 from fabric C on the bottom left corner of one (1) 40" x 12¹/₂" rectangle from fabric A.
- Feel free to place the pattern where you think it fits best!



DIAGRAM 1

 After placing the paw template, sew the two short ends of the 40" x 12½" rectangle from fabric A. You will end up with a cilynder shape piece.



• Sew template 1 from fabric A to the bottom opening. Make sure that the direction of your fabric is correct.

• Pin all the edges first, and sew at 1/4".



Lining:

DIAGRAM 4

- Repeat these steps with one (1) 40" x 12½" rectangle from fabric B and one (1) template 1 from fabric B.
- Turn the piece from fabric A right side out and leave the lining right side in.
- Place the rlining into the piece from fabric A.
- Fold the top edge down around ½" into the bucket and fold it once more around 1" and top stitch.



DIAGRAM 5

- Take the two (2) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips from fabric A
- Gate fold the strip and then fold in half.
- Press and edge stitch both sides.



DIAGRAM 6

- fold the short ends about ½" and sew one end on the left side of the basket and the other end on the opposite side.
- Repeat the same steps with the other strip and sew it on the right side of the basket.
