EXTRA MATERIALS

10" zipper

Tiny Colored Pompoms

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

- One (1) template #1 from fabric A.
- One (1) template #5 from fabric B.
- One (1) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle of fabric **B**.
- One (1) template #2 from fabric C.
- One (1) template #3 from fabric D.
- One (1) template #4 from fabric **E**.
- One (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" strip from fabric **F**.
- One (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9" strip from fabric **F**.

• One (1) 11/2" x 10" strip from fabric F.

- One (1) 11/2" x 11" strip from fabric F.
- Two (2) 10½" x 8½" from fabric G.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼"seam allowance.

Take the template #5 from fabric B and one
(1) 1½" x 11" strip from fabric F, sew the strip to the template #5 as shown in the diagram below.





DIAGRAM 1

 Take the template #3 from fabric D and sew it as shown in the diagram below.





 ${\rm DIAGRAM}~2$

- Take one (1) 1½" x 10" strip and sew it as shown in the diagram below.
- Press and set aside.





DIAGRAM 3

Take the template #1 from fabric A and one
(1) 1½" x 5" strip from fabric F, sew the strip to the template #1 as shown in the diagram below.



DIAGRAM 4

- Take the template #2 from fabric C and sew it as shown in the diagram below.
- Press.




DIAGRAM 5

- Sew both units together as shown in the diagram below.
- Attached the remaining strip from fabric F.
- Press.




DIAGRAM 6

- Take the template #4 from fabric E and sew it as shown in diagram 7.
- Press.



DIAGRAM 7

- Trim the excess fabric to create a $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.
- Quilt as desired.



ASSEMBLING THE CLUTCH

- Change your sewing foot for the zipper foot.
- Place one (1) 10½" x 8½" rectangle from fabric G right side up on your work surface.
- Center the zipper, right side up, on top of the fabric.
- Place your Patched fabric piece on top of the lining/zipper, right side down.
- you should have lining face up, zipper face up, main face down.
- Stitch along the edge of the zipper.





DIAGRAM 10

 Fold back and press the main fabric and the lining to expose the finished edges along the zipper.



DIAGRAM 11

Open the zipper and repeat the previous steps for the other side, but this time use one (1) 10½" x 8½" rectangle from fabric G and one (1) 10½" x 8½" rectangle from fabric B for the backing.



DIAGRAM 12

• If you'll like to add pompoms at the bottom or any type of trim this is the time.

- Pin the trim to the front bottom rectangle. pompoms should be pointing towards the zipper.
- Top stitch close to the edge to hold the trim on place.



DIAGRAM 13

- Separate the Patched piece together with the backing and then the lining pieces together on each side of the bag fold the "flaps" so that you are matching the exterior fabrics right sides together, and the lining fabrics right sides together, make sure that the pompoms are out of your way.
- Pin in place to form one large rectangle with exterior pieces to one side and lining pieces to the other side.
- The red line in the picture above shows your stitching line.
- Stitch, with ½" seam allowance, all the way around the clutch, leaving a 4-5 inch opening in the LINING side of the bag for turning.



DIAGRAM 14

- Turn the clucth inside out and handstitch the lining opening.
- Press.
- Voila!


