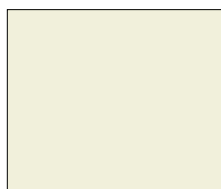

# Boo- berry

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric **A** SNS-13028 1 yd.

Fabric **B** PE-408 1 yd.

BACKING FABRIC  
PE-408 1 yds (Included)

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS  
Pillow Stuffing (Suggested)

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

$\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances are included.  
WOF means width of fabric.

- Start by removing the "Spooky & Sweeter plushies" part from fabric **A**.

See the dotted red frame on diagram below for reference.



DIAGRAM 1

## CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

- Following the scissor symbol and the outline of each element cut each out figure.

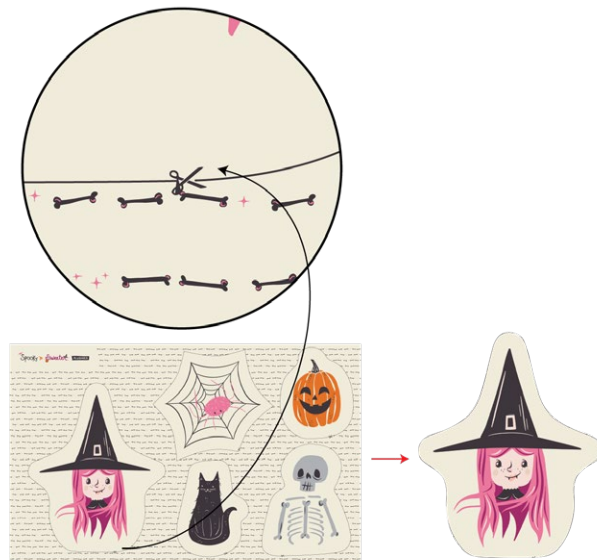


DIAGRAM 2

- Use the cut outs as templates to cut the backing of each plushie.

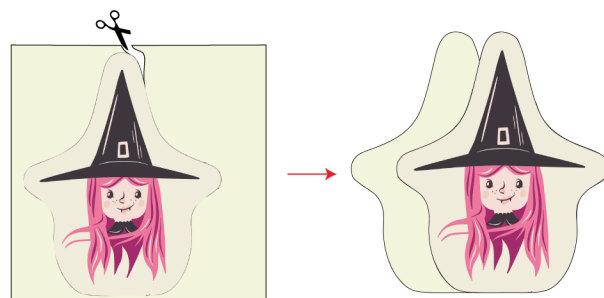


DIAGRAM 3

- Place one of the cut outs from fabric **A** and **B** facing right sides, sew at  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edges and leave about 3 "to 4" opening.
- Turn the pieces inside out and insert pillow stuffing.



DIAGRAM 4

- Handstitch or machine stitch the opening.



DIAGRAM 5

- Enjoy!



DIAGRAM 6

- Repeat the same steps with rest of the figures.
