

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Pillow 1

Fabric A FUS-BL-1804 1/4 yd.

Fabric B PE-479 ³/₄ yd.

Pillow 2

Fabric A FUS-BL-1808 1/4 yd.

Fabric B PE-471 ³/₄ yd.

Pillow 3

Fabric A FUS-BL-1803 1/4 yd.

Fabric B PE-472 3/4 yd.

BACKING FABRIC

Pillow 1- Fabric **B** -(Included)

Pillow 2- Fabric B -(Included)

Pillow 3- Fabric B -(Included)

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

"4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

- Twenty (20) triangle templates from fabric A.
- Twenty four (24) triangle templates from fabric B.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with 1/4" seam allowance.

 Take fabric A and B triangle template cut outs and join them in rows following in the diagram below.




DIAGRAM 1

• Join rows 1-4 and trim the edges. The pillow should measure $18\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13".

• Repeat the same instructions for pillows 2 and 3.










DIAGRAM 3

CREATING THE BACK PILLOW

Sew all rights sides together with $\frac{1}{4}$ "seam allowance. Press open.

- Take both 14" x 13" rectangles from fabric B.
- Fold one bottom edge ½" towards the wrong side of the fabric of one of the rectangle.
- Fold the same edge ½" again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Repeat the same for the top edge of the bottom piece.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric **B** and align it wrong side up to the right side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric B and align it wrong side up to the left side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at ½".
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a 18" x 12½" pillow form and enjoy!

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
