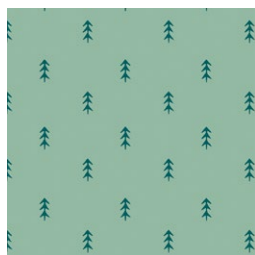

Fabric **E** PE-452 F8

Fabric **F** FUS-FO-2107 F8

Pillow 2

Fabric **A** FUS-FO-2108 $\frac{3}{4}$ yd.

Fabric **B** FUS-FO-2102 $\frac{1}{8}$ yd.

Fabric **C** FE-515 $\frac{1}{8}$ yd.

Fabric **D** PE-494 F8

Fabric **E** DSE-711 F8

Fabric **F** PE-400 F8

BACKING FABRIC

Pillow 1 Fabric **A** - (Included)

Pillow 2 Fabric **A** - (Included)

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

$\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances are included.

WOF means width of fabric.

- One (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip from fabric **A**.
- Two (2) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square from fabric **A**.
- One (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip from fabric **B**.
- One (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip from fabric **C**.
- Two (2) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square from fabric **D**.
- One (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square from fabric **E**.
- One (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square from fabric **F**.
- One (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square from fabric **F**.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

- Start by sewing fabrics **A**, **B** and **C**.
- Take the square template, place it on point and cut 2 pieces.



DIAGRAM 1

Half Square Triangle Construction:

- Take one (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square from fabrics **A** and **D**. Align them face to face.
- Draw a line diagonally corner to corner using a mechanical pencil or frixion pen.
- Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side from the drawn lines.
- Cut the pieces apart along the marked diagonal line.
- Press and trim to a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " perfect square.

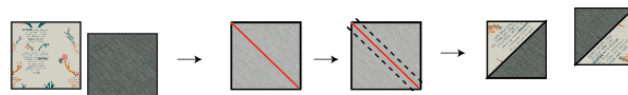


DIAGRAM 2

- Repeat the same instructions for the following fabric combination: **D-E, A-F**.

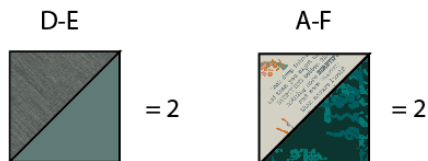


DIAGRAM 3

- Now, take all your pieces including the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabric **F** and follow the diagram below for each row assembly.

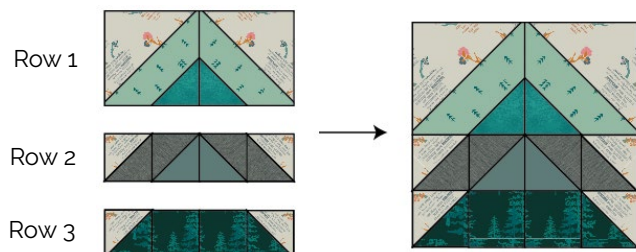
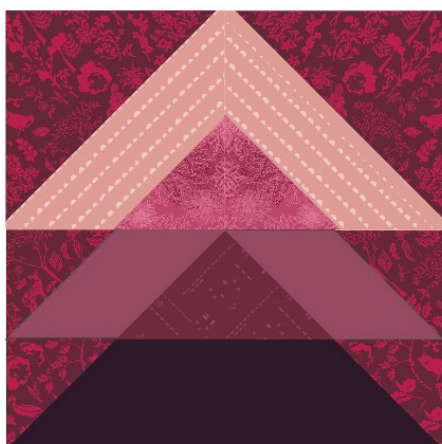


DIAGRAM 4

- Repeat the same instructions for the other pillow.
- Quilt them as desired.



CREATING THE BACK PILLOW

*Sew all rights sides together with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.
Press open.*

- Take both $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12" rectangles from fabric **A**.
- Fold one bottom edge $\frac{1}{2}$ " towards the wrong side of the fabric of one of the rectangle.
- Fold the same edge $\frac{1}{2}$ " again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Repeat the same for the top edge of the bottom piece.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric **A** and align it wrong side up to the top part of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric **A** and align it wrong side up to bottom side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a 16" x 16" pillow form and enjoy!
