CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.

- Fifteen (15) 2 1/2" squares from fabric **A**.
- Fifteen (15) 2 1/2" squares from fabric **B**.
- Fifteen (15) 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **C**.
- Fifteen (15) 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **C**.
- Fifteen (15) 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **D**.
- Fifteen (15) 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **D**.
- Fifteen (15) 4 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **E**.
- Fifteen (15) 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **E**.
- One (1) 27" x WOF rectangle from fabric **F**.
- Two (2) 12 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles from fabric **F**.
- Two (2) 8 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles from fabric **F**.
- Fifteen (15) 4 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **F**.
- Fifteen (15) 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **F**.
- Fifteen (15) 5 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **G**.
- Fifteen (15) 4 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **G**.
- One (1) 20" x 62" rectangle from fabric **H**.
- Two (2) 10" x 62" rectangle from fabric **H**.
- Two (2) 14" x 12" rectangle from fabric **H**.
- Two (2) 14" x 4" rectangle from fabric **H**.
- Fifteen (15) 5 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **H**.
- Fifteen (15) 4 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **H**.
- Three (3) 6" x WOF strips from fabric **I**.
- Fifteen (15) 6 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **I**.
- Fifteen (15) 5 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **I**.
- Two (2) 14" squares from fabric **I**.
- Two (2) 13 1/2" squares from fabric **I**.
- Fifteen (15) 6 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **J**.
- Fifteen (15) 5 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **J**.
- Fifteen (15) 7 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **K**.
- Fifteen (15) 6 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles from fabric **K**.

- Fifteen (15) 7½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric **L**.
- Fifteen (15) 6½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric **L**.
- Fifteen (15) 8½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric **M**.
- Fifteen (15) 7½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric **M**.
- Fifteen (15) 8½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric **N**.
- Fifteen (15) 7½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric **N**.
- Two (2) 12½" x 2½" rectangles from fabric **O**.
- Two (2) 8½" x 2½" rectangles from fabric **O**.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance.

Bag Strap:

- Take three (3) 6" x WOF strips from fabric **I**.
- Trim the selvage from the edges.
- Join the strips into a really long strip.
- Fold the strip in half to create a center crease.
- Fold the edges towards the center crease and press to have a total of three creases.
- Place a 1½" strip of batting on the wrong side of one of the inside rectangles of the strip.
- Fold the outer edges towards the inside covering the batting.




DIAGRAM 1

- Join the ends of the strap to make a huge circle.
- Edge stitch the edges of the strap to keep the fabric in place.




DIAGRAM 2

Binding:

- Take one (1) 27" x WOF rectangle from fabric **F**.
- Cut it into 2" strips at 45 degrees from the bottom edge.
- Join all the strips to make a really long 2" bias strip.




DIAGRAM 3

Blocks 1 & 2:

- Take fifteen (15) 2½" squares from fabrics **A** and **B**, fifteen (15) 2½" x 1½" rectangles from fabrics **C** and **D** and fifteen (15) 3½" x 1½" rectangles from fabrics **C** and **D**.
- Block 1: join **A** to **C**.
- Block 2: join **B** to **D**.

DIAGRAM 4

- Take fifteen (15) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from fabrics **E** and **F**, and fifteen (15) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from fabrics **E** and **F**.
- Join them as following the diagram:




DIAGRAM 5

- Take fifteen (15) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from fabrics **G** and **H**, and fifteen (15) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from fabrics **G** and **H**.
- Join them as following the diagram:




DIAGRAM 6

- Take fifteen (15) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from fabrics **I** and **J** and fifteen (15) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from fabrics **I** and **J**.
- Join them as following the diagram:




DIAGRAM 7

- Take fifteen (15) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from fabrics **K** and **L** and fifteen (15) $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from fabrics **K** and **L**.
- Join them following the diagram:




DIAGRAM 8

- Take fifteen (15) $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from fabrics **M** and **N** and fifteen (15) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from fabrics **M** and **N**.
- Join them following the diagram:



DIAGRAM 9

Blocks 3 & 4:

- Take one (1) block 1 and block 2, one (1) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from fabrics **F** and **O**, and two (2) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from fabrics **F** and **O**.
- Join them into blocks 3 and 4 following the diagram:




DIAGRAM 10

Blocks 5, 6 & 7:

- Take fourteen (14) block 1 and 2 and join them into block 5, 6 and 7:




DIAGRAM 11

Quilt:

- Take blocks 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, one (1) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip from fabrics **F** and **O**, one (1) 20 " x 62 " rectangle from fabric **H**, two (2) 10 " x 62 " rectangle from fabric **H**, two (2) 14 " x 12 " rectangles from fabric **H**, two (2) 14 " x 4 " rectangle from fabric **H** and batting.
- Layer them using fabric **H** as backing and quilt each block separately.





DIAGRAM 12

- Take two (2) $13\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabric **I** and two (2) 14 " squares from fabric **I**.
- Layer them with batting and quilt them.
- Trim each square to $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".




DIAGRAM 13

Cut & clean edges:

- For blocks 5, 6 and 7, measure from the center out $24\frac{1}{4}$ " and trim each block so they will be $48\frac{1}{2}$ " long:




DIAGRAM 14

Attaching the strap:

- Take block 6 and the circular bag strap.
- Align the center of the block with the center of the bag strap.
- Pin the strap in place.
- Align the strap with the seam of the vertical strips of the block to keep it straight.
- Double stitch the strap and stop stitching and make a u turn to continue stitching where the diagram indicates.




DIAGRAM 15

- Align the top and bottom edge of block 6 and attache the 30" or longer zipper there.
- Trim the excess zipper.
- Clean the raw edge that is next to the zipper with the binding form fabric **F**.




DIAGRAM 16

- Take block 3, 4, quilted rectangles from fabrics **O** and **F**, and two (2) 16" or longer zippers.
- Attach the zippers.
- Clean the raw edges attached to the zipper with the binding.




DIAGRAM 17

- Join block 3 to block 5 and block 4 to block 7 aligning the seams of block 3 to the seams of the center of block 5, and aligning the seams of block 4 to the seams for the center of block 4.
- For fabric placement and attachment follow the diagram:




DIAGRAM 18

- Align and join the top and bottom edge of block 5. Clean the raw seam with binding.
- Repeat the same process for block 7.




DIAGRAM 19

Side Pockets:

- Join the other sides of block 3 to block 5 and the other sides of block 4 to block 7.
- Follow the diagram below to align the seams of block 5 to the seams of block 3, and the seams of block 7 to the seams of block 4.
- Clean the inside seams with binding.


