FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric A	SSP-26615	Fat 8.
Fabric B	SSP-26610	Fat 8.
Fabric C	SSP-26612	Fat 8.
Fabric D	DEN-L-4000	Fat 8.

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

½" Velcro strips (*Suggested*)

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

¼" seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.

- One (1) 13½" x 4½" rectangle from fabrics **A**, **B** and **C**.
- Three (3) 2½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric **D**.

Note

- These measurements are for a 12" circumference jar.
- For a different size measure the circumference of your jar and add ¾" to the length of the sleeve.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance.

- Start by folding one (1) 13½" x 4½" rectangle lengthwise from fabric **B**.




DIAGRAM 1

- Sew at ¼" away from the edges on the sides and bottom and leave approx 2" opening.




DIAGRAM 2

- Turn the piece inside out and carefully edge stitch the opening.



DIAGRAM 3

- Cut a 1¾" x ½" piece of double side velcro tape and sew one (1) piece on the right side of the fabric measuring about ⅛" from the side edge.
- Sew the other piece on the opposite side of the wrong side of the piece.




DIAGRAM 4

- Take one (1) 2½" x 1½" rectangles from fabric **D**, place it in the middle of the previously sewn piece and with embroidery thread add your favorite word.
- Enjoy.




DIAGRAM 5
