



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS Steam-a- Seam (Suggested)

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

¹/₄" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of the fabric.

Pillow 1:

- One (1) $12^{1/2}$ " square from fabric **A**.
- One (1) template 1.1 from fabric **B**.
- One (1) template 1.2 from fabric **B**.
- One (1) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square from fabric **C**.
- Two (2) 12¹/₂" x 8¹/₂ rectangles from fabric **C**. (Back of the pillow)

Pillow 2:

- One (1) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square from fabric A.
- One (1) template 2.1 from fabric **B**.
- One (1) template 2.2 from fabric B.
- One (1) $12^{\frac{1}{2}}$ square from fabric C.
- Two (2) 12¹/₂" x 8¹/₂ rectangles from fabric **C**. (Back of the pillow)

Pillow 3:

- One (1) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square from fabric **A**.
- One (1) template 3.1 from fabric **B**.
- One (1) template 3.2 from fabric **B**.
- One (1) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square from fabric C.
- Two (2) 12¹/₂" x 8¹/₂ rectangles from fabric **C**. (Back of the pillow)

CONSTRUCTION

Pillow 1

- Place one (1) 12¹/₂" square from fabric A under one (1) 12¹/₂" square from fabric C.
- Make sure that fabric **A** is facing the wrong side of fabric **C**.
- Baste stitch both squares.




DIAGRAM 1

- Place the reverse applique template 1 around the center of fabric **C** and using the template as guide sew ¹/₄" away from the edges of the template.
- Now, cut around ¼" in from the stitch that you made, and that will reveal fabric **A**.




DIAGRAM 2

- Place the reverse applique template 1 around the center of fabric **C** and using the template as guide sew ¹/₄" away from the edges of the template.
- Now, cut around ¼" infrom the stitch that you made, and that will reveal fabric **A**.




DIAGRAM 3

Pillow 2

- Place one (1) 12¹/₂" square from fabric **A** under one (1) 12¹/₂" square from fabric **C**.
- Make sure that fabric **A** is facing the wrong side of fabric **C** and bast stitch both squares.





DIAGRAM 4

- Place the reverse applique template 2 around the center of fabric **C** and using the template as guide sew ¹/₄" away from the edges of the template.
- Now, cut around ¼" in from the stitch that you made and that will reveal fabric **A**.






DIAGRAM 6

Pillow 3

- Place one (1) 12¹/₂" square from fabric A under one (1) 12¹/₂" square from fabric C.
- Make sure that fabric **A** is facing the wrong side of fabric **C** and baste stitch both squares.




DIAGRAM 7

- Place the reverse applique template 3 around the center of fabric C and using the template as guide sew ¼" away from the edges of the template.
- Now, cut around ¼" in from the stitch that you made, and that will reveal fabric **A**.




DIAGRAM 8

• Take one (1) template 3.1 from fabric **B** and using steam a seam iron it on the left side, and template 3.2 from fabric **B** on the right side. See diagram below for reference.




DIAGRAM 9

CREATING THE BACK PILLOW

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance. Press open.

- Take both 12½" x 8½" rectangles from fabric C.
- Fold one bottom edge ½" towards the wrong side of the fabric of one of the rectangle.
- Fold the same edge ½" again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Repeat the same for the top edge of the bottom piece.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric C and align it wrong side up to the top side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric C and align it wrong side up to the bottom side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at 1/4".
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a 12" x 12" pillow form and enjoy!




