## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

## Plllow 1

- One (1) 18 " $\times 1^{1 ⁄ 2} / 2$ strip from fabric $A$.
- One (1) 18 " $\times 1^{11 / 2 "}$ strip from fabric B.
- Two (2) 18 " $\times 1^{11 / 2 " ~ s t r i p s ~ f r o m ~ f a b r i c ~ C . ~}$
- One (1) $18^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{112} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip from fabric $D$.
- Two (2) $18^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from fabric E.
- One (1) $18^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip from fabric $F$.
- Two (2) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{11 / 2 "}$ strips from fabric $G$.
- Two (2) $10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{11 / 2 " ~ s t r i p s ~ f r o m ~ f a b r i c ~} G$.
- One (1) $101 / 2$ " square from fabric $G$.
- Two (2) $1011 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ " rectangles from fabric $G$. (Pillow Backing)


## PIllow 2

- Four (4) $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{112} / 2$ strips from fabric A.
- Four (4) $1^{1 ⁄ 2} / 2$ squares from fabric $A$
- Three (3) $3^{1 ⁄ 2 "} \times 1^{11 / 2 " ~ s t r i p s ~ f r o m ~ f a b r i c ~ B . ~}$
- Two (2) $1^{1 ⁄ 2}$ " squares from fabric B.
- One (1) $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip from fabric $C$.
- Two (2) $1^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares from fabric C.
- One (1) $1^{1 / 2 "}$ square from fabric $D$.
- Two (2) $10^{1 ⁄ 2 " ~} \times 2$ " strips from fabric E.
- Four (4) 5 " $\times 1 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ " strips from fabric $E$.
- Four (4) 4 " $\times 11 / 2 "$ strips from fabric $E$.
- Four (4) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips from fabric $E$.
- Two (2) 2" $\times 1^{1122 "}$ strips from fabric $E$.
- Two (2) $101 / 2$ " $\times 8$ " rectangles from fabric $\mathbf{E}$. (Pillow Backing)


## CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance.

## Pillow 1

- Start by sewing 18 " $\times 1^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from fabric $A, E, B$, C, F and D. See diagram below for reference.


DIAGRAM 1

- You will end up with a $18^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip block.

## Strip Set 1

- Cut nine ( 9 ) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ vertical strips.



## Strip Set 2

- Take one (1) strip 1 and unsew the bottom square from fabric $\mathbf{C}$, and sew it above fabric A square of the same strip. Repeat this step one more time. You need a total of two (2) strip set 2.

## Strip Set 3

- Take one (1) strip 1 and unsew between fabric F and $D$, and sew it above fabric $A$ square of the same strip. Repeat this step one more time. You need a total of two (2) strip set 3



## Strip Set 4

- Take one (1) strip 1 and unsew between fabric E and $F$, and sew it above fabric A square of the same strip. Repeat this step one more time. You need a total of two (2) strip set 4.

## Strip Set 5

- Take one (1) strip 1 and unsew between fabric $C$ and $E$ and sew it above fabric A square of the same strip. You need a total of two (2) strip set 5 .

- Arrange all strip sets as shown on diagram below.


DIAGRAM 8

- Sew one (1) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1} / 2$ " strip from fabric $G$ on each side of the previously sewn block.


DIAGRAM 9

- Sew one (1) $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip from fabric $G$ on the top and bottom of the sewn block.


DIAGRAM 10

- Take one (1) $10^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from fabric $G$ and fold it in half into a rectangle and fold it again into a square, press in order to have a crease.
- Open the square and use the crease as guides.


DIAGRAM 11

- Place the Reverse applique template and align the side notches of the template to the horizontal crease of the $101 / 2$ " square from fabric $G$.
- Using any erasable fabric pen trace the heart shape onto the fabric.

- Place the heart traced fabric on top of the patchy block. Make sure that both pieces are facing right side up. Pin to hold both pieces in place and using a small length stitch sew at $11 / 4$ away the heart shape.


DIAGRAM 13

- Using small scissors, start cutting the top layer following the drawn heart shape. That will reveal the patchy block under. Enjoy.

## Pillow 2

## Strip Set 1

- Join two (2) $3^{1} / 2$ " $\times 1^{11 / 2 " ~ s t r i p s ~ f r o m ~ f a b r i c ~} A$ and one (1) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 1^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip from fabric $B$.
- Cut two (2) $1^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips vertically. See diagram below for reference.

## Strip Set 2

- Join two (2) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 1^{112} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from fabrics A and B, and one (1) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 1^{1} 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip from fabric C, after joining the strips cut two (2) $11 / 2 "$ strips vertically .



## Strip Set 3

- Join two (2) $1122^{\prime \prime}$ squares from fabrics A, B, C one (1) $1^{1} / 2 "$ square from fabric $D$ in the order shown on diagram below. You will just need one strip set 3.

DIAGRAM 17

- Arrange all strip sets and fabric E pieces into seven (7) rows see diagram 18 for reference.


DIAGRAM 18

- Sew all rows together.

- Sew one (1) $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ " strip from fabric E on the top and bottom of the sewn block.


DIAGRAM 20

- Quilt as desired.



## CREATING THE BACK PILLOW

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance. Press open.

- Take both $101 / 2 " \times 8$ " rectangles from fabric G for pillow 1, and fabric E for pillow 2.
- Fold one bottom edge $1 / 2$ " towards the wrong side of the fabric of one of the rectangle.
- Fold the same edge $1 / 2$ " again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Repeat the same for the top edge of the bottom piece.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric G and align it wrong side up to the right side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric $\mathbf{G}$ and align it wrong side up to the left side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at $1 / 4$ ".
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a 10 " $\times 10^{\prime \prime}$ pillow form and enjoy!
