Fabric <b>B</b>	TAT39910	FQ.
Fabric <b>C</b>	TAT39906	FQ.
Fabric <b>D</b>	TAT39904	FQ.
Fabric <b>E</b>	PE522	FQ.
Fabric <b>F</b>	PE531	FQ.
Fabric <b>G</b>	DENL4000	FQ.

### PILLOW 2

Fabric <b>A</b>	TAT39902	F8.
Fabric <b>B</b>	TAT39905	F8.
Fabric <b>C</b>	TAT39901	F8.
Fabric <b>D</b>	TAT39904	F8.
Fabric <b>E</b>	DENL4000	FQ.

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

*¼" seam allowances are included.  
WOF means width of fabric.*

### Pillow 1

- One (1) 18" x 1½" strip from fabric **A**.
- One (1) 18" x 1½" strip from fabric **B**.
- Two (2) 18" x 1½" strips from fabric **C**.
- One (1) 18" x 1½" strip from fabric **D**.
- Two (2) 18" x 1½" strips from fabric **E**.
- One (1) 18" x 1½" strip from fabric **F**.
- Two (2) 8½" x 1½" strips from fabric **G**.
- Two (2) 10½" x 1½" strips from fabric **G**.
- One (1) 10½" square from fabric **G**.
- Two (2) 10½" x 8" rectangles from fabric **G**.  
(Pillow Backing)

### Pillow 2

- Four (4) 3½" x 1½" strips from fabric **A**.
- Four (4) 1½" squares from fabric **A**.
- Three (3) 3½" x 1½" strips from fabric **B**.
- Two (2) 1½" squares from fabric **B**.
- One (1) 3½" x 1½" strip from fabric **C**.
- Two (2) 1½" squares from fabric **C**.
- One (1) 1½" square from fabric **D**.
- Two (2) 10½" x 2" strips from fabric **E**.
- Four (4) 5" x 1½" strips from fabric **E**.
- Four (4) 4" x 1½" strips from fabric **E**.
- Four (4) 3" x 1½" strips from fabric **E**.
- Two (2) 2" x 1½" strips from fabric **E**.
- Two (2) 10½" x 8" rectangles from fabric **E**.  
(Pillow Backing)

# CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

## Pillow 1

- Start by sewing 18" x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips from fabric **A**, **E**, **B**, **C**, **F** and **D**. See diagram below for reference.

- You will end up with a 18" x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strip block.

## Strip Set 1

- Cut nine (9)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " vertical strips.

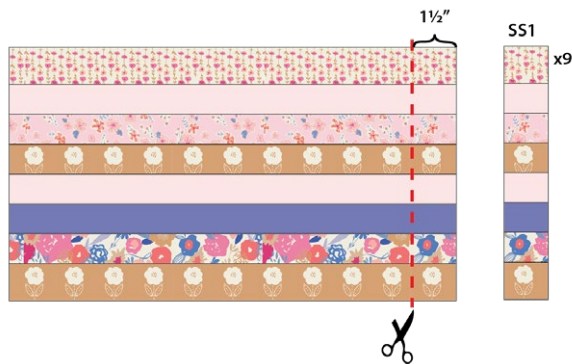

## Strip Set 2

- Take one (1) strip 1 and unsew the bottom square from fabric **C**, and sew it above fabric **A** square of the same strip. Repeat this step one more time. You need a total of two (2) strip set 2.

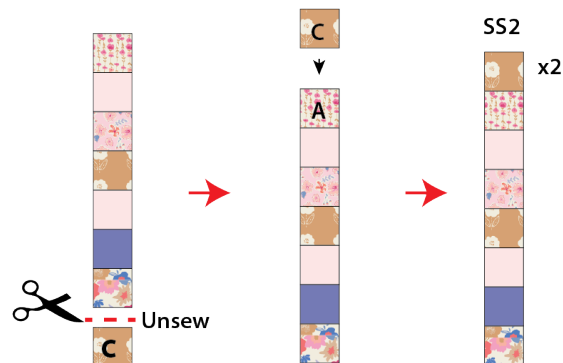

## Strip Set 3

- Take one (1) strip 1 and unsew between fabric **F** and **D**, and sew it above fabric **A** square of the same strip. Repeat this step one more time. You need a total of two (2) strip set 3

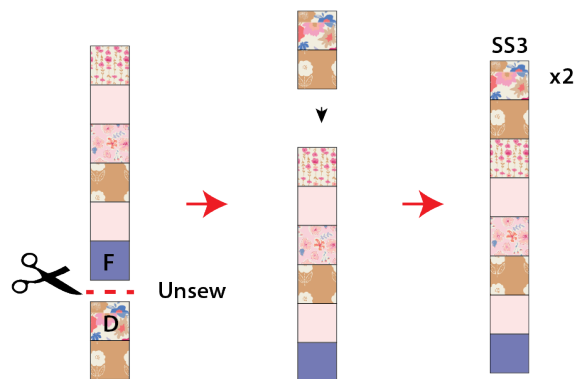

## Strip Set 4

- Take one (1) strip 1 and unsew between fabric **E** and **F**, and sew it above fabric **A** square of the same strip. Repeat this step one more time. You need a total of two (2) strip set 4.

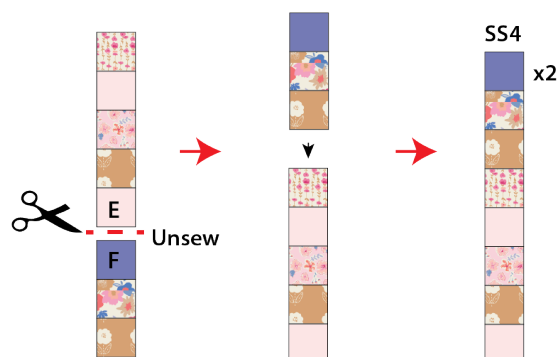

## Strip Set 5

- Take one (1) strip 1 and unsew between fabric **C** and **E** and sew it above fabric **A** square of the same strip. You need a total of two (2) strip set 5.

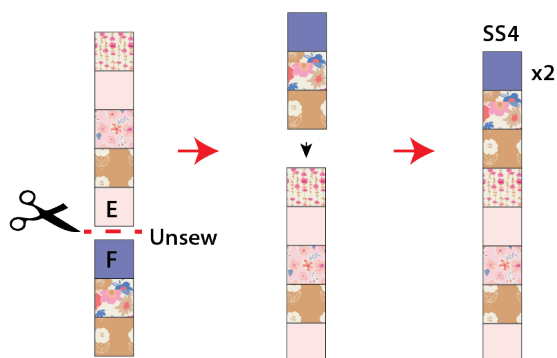

- Arrange all strip sets as shown on diagram below.

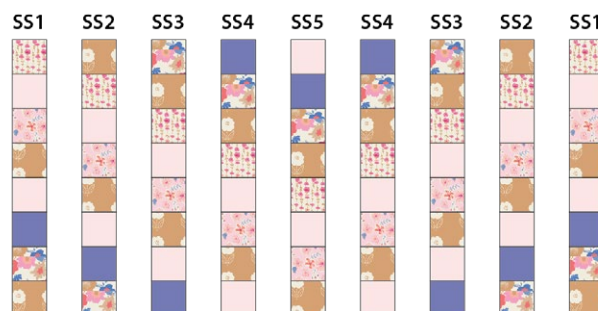


DIAGRAM 8

- Sew one (1)  $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$  strip from fabric **G** on each side of the previously sewn block.

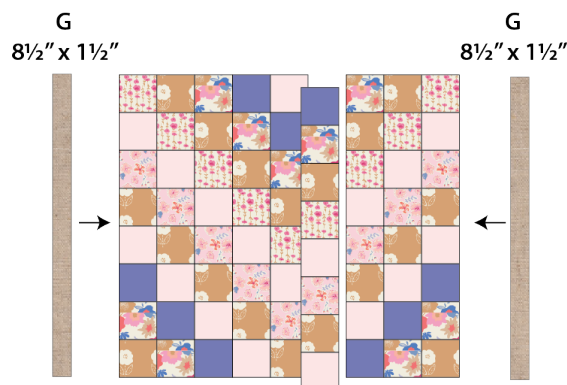


DIAGRAM 9

- Sew one (1)  $10\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$  strip from fabric **G** on the top and bottom of the sewn block.

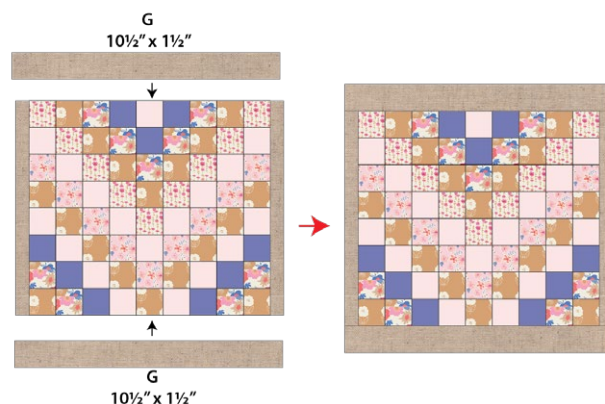


DIAGRAM 10

- Take one (1) 10½" square from fabric **G** and fold it in half into a rectangle and fold it again into a square, press in order to have a crease.
- Open the square and use the crease as guides.

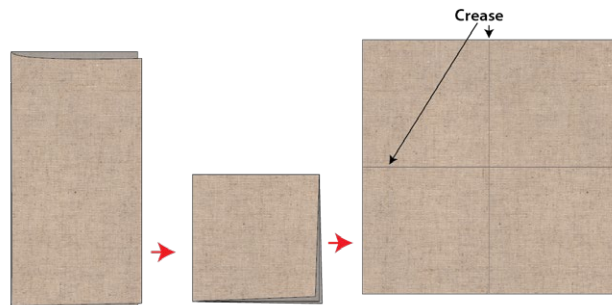


DIAGRAM 11

- Place the Reverse applique template and align the side notches of the template to the horizontal crease of the 10½" square from fabric **G**.
- Using any erasable fabric pen trace the heart shape onto the fabric.

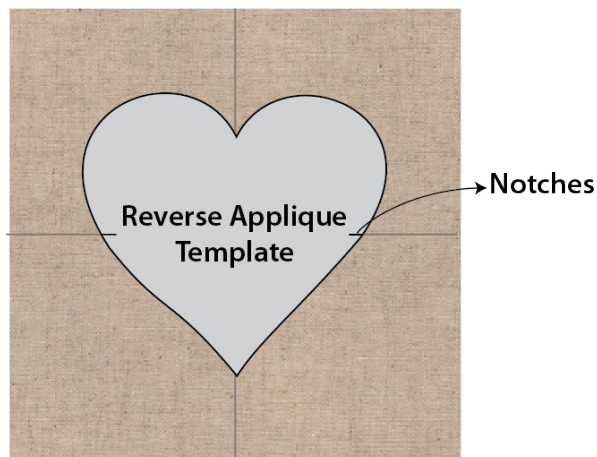


DIAGRAM 12

- Place the heart traced fabric on top of the patchy block. Make sure that both pieces are facing right side up. Pin to hold both pieces in place and using a small length stitch sew at ¼" away the heart shape.

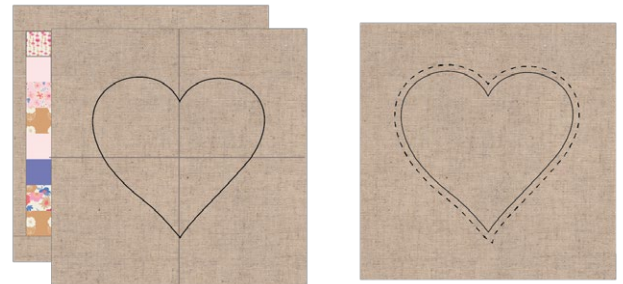


DIAGRAM 13

- Using small scissors, start cutting the top layer following the drawn heart shape. That will reveal the patchy block under. Enjoy.

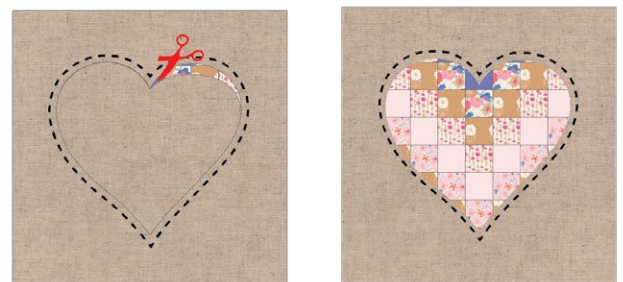

## Pillow 2

### Strip Set 1

- Join two (2) 3½" x 1½" strips from fabric **A** and one (1) 3½" x 1½" strip from fabric **B**.
- Cut two (2) 1½" strips vertically. See diagram below for reference.

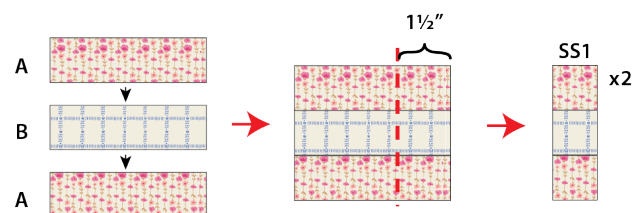

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- Arrange all strip sets and fabric **E** pieces into seven (7) rows see diagram 18 for reference.



Row 1	E 5" x 1½"	A 1½"	E 5" x 1½"
Row 2	E 4" x 1½"	SS1	E 4" x 1½"
Row 3	E 3" x 1½"	SS2	E 3" x 1½"
Row 4	E 2" x 1½"	SS3	E 2" x 1½"
Row 5	E 3" x 1½"	SS2	E 3" x 1½"
Row 6	E 4" x 1½"	SS1	E 4" x 1½"
Row 7	E 5" x 1½"	A 1½"	E 5" x 1½"

DIAGRAM 18

- Join two (2) 1½" squares from fabrics **A, B, C** one (1) 1½" square from fabric **D** in the order shown on diagram below. You will just need one strip set 3.



- Sew all rows together.

- Sew one (1)  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" strip from fabric **E** on the top and bottom of the sewn block.

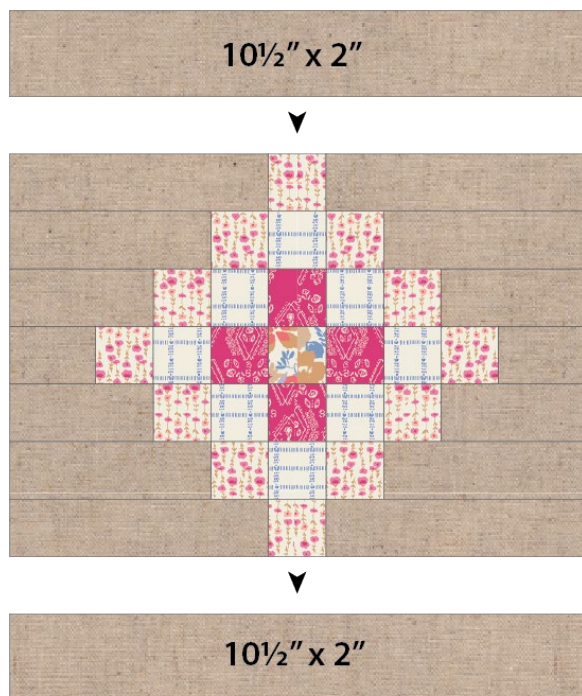

- Quilt as desired.

## CREATING THE BACK PILLOW

*Sew all rights sides together with  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press open.*

- Take both  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8" rectangles from fabric **G** for pillow 1, and fabric **E** for pillow 2.
- Fold one bottom edge  $\frac{1}{2}$ " towards the wrong side of the fabric of one of the rectangle.
- Fold the same edge  $\frac{1}{2}$ " again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Repeat the same for the top edge of the bottom piece.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric **G** and align it wrong side up to the right side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric **G** and align it wrong side up to the left side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at  $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a 10" x 10" pillow form and enjoy!

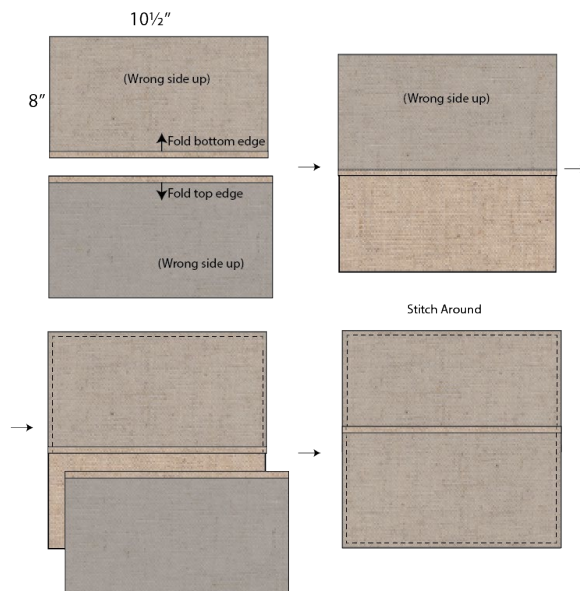

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
