Steam-a-seam (Suggested)

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

"4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

One (1) template M1 from fabric A.

One (1) template S1 from fabric A.

One (1) template M2 from fabric B.

One (1) template S2 from fabric B.

One (1) template A2 from fabric B.

One (1) template C1 from fabric B.

Nine (9) template 3 from fabric B.

Four (4) template 5 from fabric B.

One (1) template M3 from fabric C.

One (1) template A3 from fabric C.

One (1) template A1 from fabric D.

One (1) template M4 from fabric D.

One (1) template A4 from fabric E.

One (1) template C2 from fabric F.

Seven (7) template 4 from fabric G.

Twelve (12) template 5 from fabric G.

Four (4) 10½" squares from fabric H.

Eight (8) 10½" x 7" rectangles from fabric H.

(Backing of pillows)

Seven (7) template C from fabrics A, B, C, D, E, F and G.

One (1) template A5 from fabric I.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance.

Pillow 1

Using steam a seam place template M1 from fabric A on top of a 10½" square from fabric H, then place template M2 from fabric B towards the bottom of template M1. See diagram below for reference.




DIAGRAM 1

 Place template M3 from fabric C on top of template M1 from fabric A.




DIAGRAM 2

 Place template M4 from fabric D at the bottom of template M2, see diagram below for reference.




DIAGRAM 3

Pillow 2

 Using steam a seam place template A1 from fabric D on top of a 10½" square from fabric H, then place template A2 from fabric B, pin it and using your favorite decorative stitch sew all around each layer.




DIAGRAM 4

 Place template A₃ from fabric C, then template A₄ from fabric E.




DIAGRAM 5

- Lastly, template A5 from fabric I. Remember to sew each template with the stitch of your choice.
- Take two (2) 10½" x 8 rectangles from fabric H
 and follow the instructions located on page 7 of
 this document for the construction of the back
 of the pillow.




DIAGRAM 6

Pillow 3

- Using steam a seam place template C1 from fabric B on top of a 10½" square from fabric H, then place template C2 from fabric F on top of template C1 from fabric B. See diagram 7.
- Now place the rain drops (template C from fabrics A, B, C, D, E, F and G) as shown on diagram 8.
- Using your favorite decorative stitch sew all around each layer to secure it.
- Take two (2) 10½" x 8" rectangles from fabric H and and follow the instructions located on page 7 of this document for the construction of the back of the pillow.






DIAGRAM 8

Pillow 4

Using steam a seam place template S1 from fabric A on the bottom of a 10½" square from fabric H, then place template S2 from fabric B on top of template S1 from fabric A.




DIAGRAM 9

Sun rays

 Place two (2) template 5 from fabric B on each side of the sun, see the diagram below for reference.




DIAGRAM 10

• Place nine (9) template 3 from fabric B on top of the sun.




DIAGRAM 11

- Place twelve (12) template 5 from fabric G
 on top of template 3 from fabric B.
- Using your favorite decorative stitch sew all around each layer to secure it.
- Take two (2) 10½" x 8 rectangles from fabric H and follow the instructions located on page 7 of this document for the construction of the back of the pillow.




DIAGRAM 12

BACK OF THE PILLOW

Sew rights sides together.

• Take both $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" rectangles from fabric H.

- Fold one bottom edge ½" towards the wrong side of the fabric of one of the rectangle.
- Fold the same edge ½" again and edge stitch the fold in place to have a clean edge.
- Repeat the same for the top edge of the bottom piece.
- Take the quilted pillow top and lay it flat right side up.
- Take one rectangle from fabric H and align it wrong side up to the top side of the pillow top.
- Take the other rectangle from fabric H and align it wrong side up to the bottom side of the pillow top.
- Pin the three pieces in place and sew around the edges at 1/4".
- Clip the corners and flip the piece to the right side of the fabric.
- Fill the pillow with a 10" x 10" pillow form and enjoy!


