FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric **A** DEN-L-4000 FQ.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

*1/4" seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.*

- One (1) 33" x 16½" rectangle from fabric **A**.
- Two (2) 28" x 4" strips from fabric **A**.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with 1/4" seam allowance.

- Take the 33" x 16½" rectangle from fabric **A** and fold the top edge down 1/4" repeat the same step at the bottom.

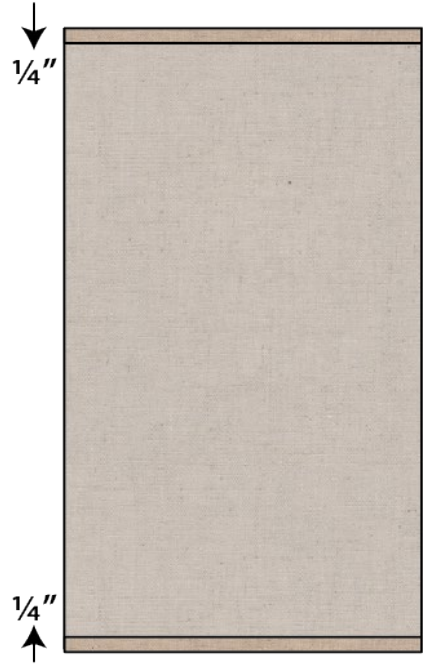


DIAGRAM 1

- Fold 1" down again and top stitch at about 1/8" from the fold. Repeat the same step with the bottom edge.

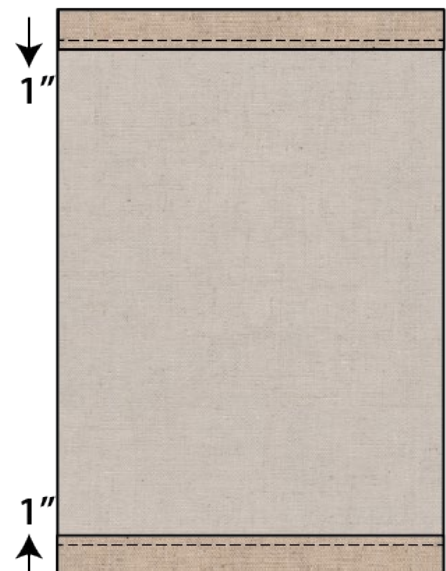


DIAGRAM 2

- Now fold the piece in half with wrong sides facing each other and sew at $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
- Trim seam allowance to reduce it to a $\frac{1}{8}$ "

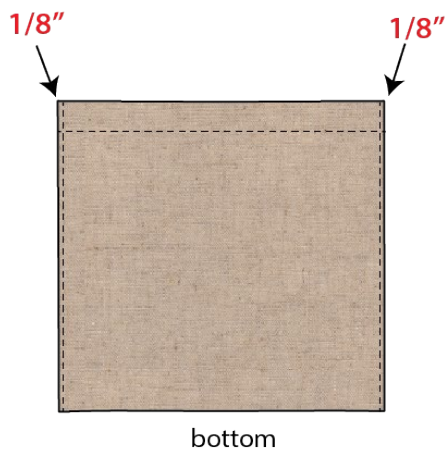
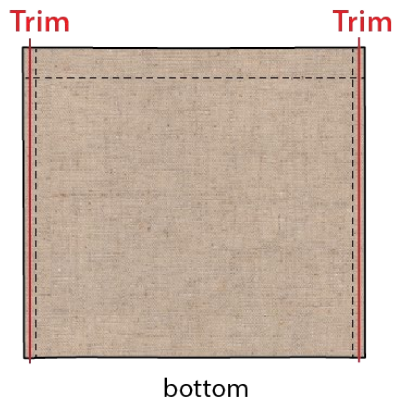


DIAGRAM 3

- Now turn the piece wrong side out and sew the sides at $\frac{3}{8}$ ".

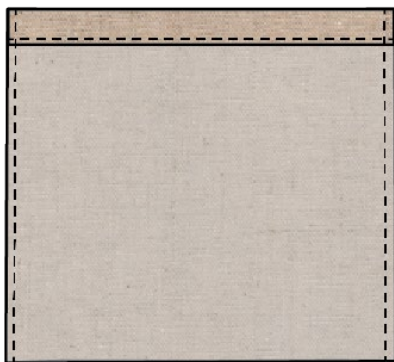


DIAGRAM 4

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- On the bottom corners of your bag, pinch the corners and, measure properly for both of the corners and pin it to make it easier.
- Sew about 2½" across the corners, and cut the excess fabric. This will give the bag volume at the bottom.

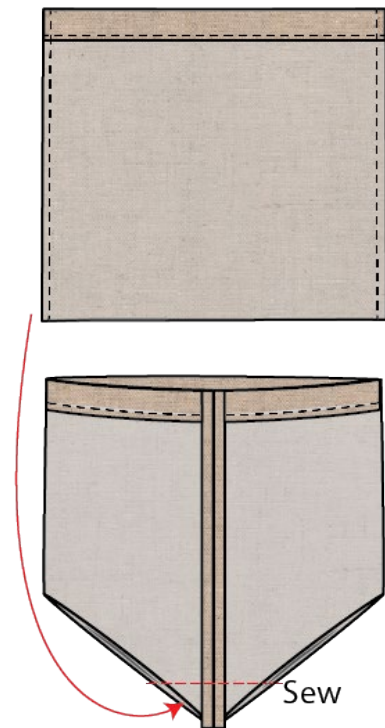


DIAGRAM 5

- Take the 28" x 4" straps , fold the short edges approx $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
- Fold both long sides of the strip towards the center and press, fold it again and top stitch.

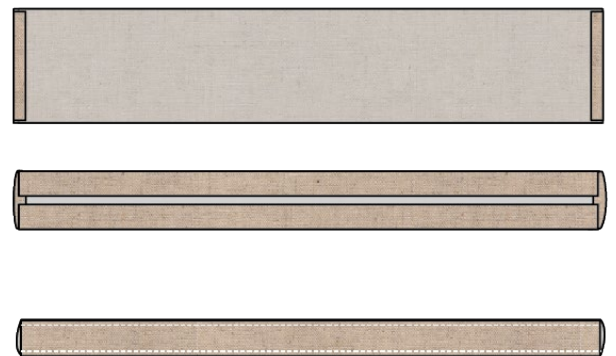


DIAGRAM 6

- Take one of the straps and measure about 4" from the sides, and lined up to the 1" fold from the top of the bag. Pin the strap and sew. repeat the same step on each sides.

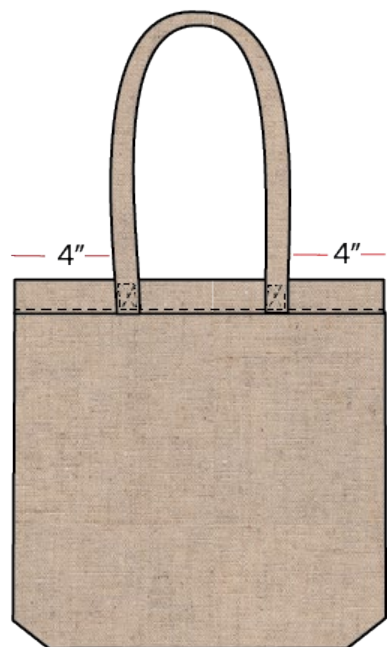


DIAGRAM 7
