FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric A FUS-W-609 ½ yd.

Fabric B FUS-W-608 ½ yd.

Fabric C PE-428 1/8 yd.

Fabric D DEN-L-4000 ½ yd.

Fabric E PE-432 ½ yd.

LINING FABRIC

Fabric E PE-432 (included)

ADDITIONAL MATERIAL

Steam-a-seam double side

fusible tape

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

- Six (6) template 3 from fabric A.
- Six (6) template 4 from fabric A.
- Four (4) template 2 from fabric B.
- Twelve (12) template 3 from fabric B.
- Eighteen (18) template 4 from fabric B.
- Ten (10) template 5 from fabric C.
- Two (2) template 1 from fabric D.
- Two (2) template 1 from fabric E (lining).

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance.

- Start by taking two (2) template 1 from fabric
 c and two (2) batting pieces and quilt them as desired.
- Once you have both pieces quilted, trim excess of batting fabric.
- Take one (1) of the quilted pieces from fabric
 C, three (3) template 3 from fabric A, three (3) template 4 from fabric A, six (6) template 3 from fabric B, nine (9) template 4 from fabric
 B and five (5) template 5 from fabric C.
- Place steam-a-seam double side fusible tape on all templates 3, 4 and 5.
- Place and distribute your template pieces following the diagram below.
- Once you are satisfied with the placement, press with iron carefully.
- To secure better your applique pieces, edge stitch with zig zag, blanket or regular straight stitch.




DIAGRAM 1

• Take the other fabric C piece and templates 3-4 and mirror the placement of the petals for the other side of the bag.

- Take four (4) fabric **B** template 2 pieces and quilt them as desired.
- Take two (2) fabric **B** template 2 pieces and place them right sides facing together.
- Sew on both curves leaving both ends unsewn.
- Snip the bottom curves.
- Flip your piece inside out.
- Repeat for the other two (2) fabric B handle pieces.




DIAGRAM 2

 Take one (1) of the bags quilted piece and one (1) handle piece. Align the ends with the top part of the bag, right sides facing and sew.



DIAGRAM 3

 Repeat the same process for the other side of the bag.

- Take both front and back of the bag and place them right sides facing.
- Pin in place and sew the sides and bottom of the bag.



DIAGRAM 4

• Take your lining pieces and sew the sides and bottom leaving about 3"-4" of opening.





DIAGRAM 5

- Flip the bag inside out and insert it making sure right sides of the lining and bag are facing each other. Match the seams and pin in place.
- Make sure the handles are facing down.
- Sew the top of the tote and pull your piece through the lining opening.
- Close the lining opening by hand or machine stitch.
- Press your bag and enjoy!





