#### Pin Cushion 1

Fabric <b>B</b>	PE-486	<sup>1</sup> ⁄8 yd.
Fabric <b>C</b>	DEN-S-2006	<sup>1</sup> ⁄4 yd.
Pin Cushion 2		
Fabric <b>A</b>	FUS-BL-1805	1⁄8 yd.
Fabric <b>B</b>	DEN-L-4000	1∕8 yd.
Fabric <b>C</b>	FUS-BL-1800	1⁄4 yd.
Pin Cushion 3		
Fabric <b>A</b>	FUS-BL-1809	<sup>1</sup> ⁄8 yd.
Fabric <b>B</b>	DEN-S-2006	<sup>1</sup> ⁄8 yd.

### CUTTING DIRECTIONS

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

#### Fabric A

Cut one (1)  $2^{1/2}$ " square.

#### Fabric B

Cut four (4)  $2^{1/2}$ " squares.

#### Fabric C


Cut four (4)  $2^{1/2}$ " squares.

Cut one (1) template 1.

Cut one (1) 3" x 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" strip.


# CONSTRUCTION

- Take (4) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square from fabric **B** and fold it corner to corner.
- Press and place each one on a 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square from fabric C towards the bottom corner (See Diagram below).










#### Section 4

DIAGRAM 1

• Place Section 1 and 2 right sides together and sew it. Repeat the same step for section 3 and 4.



Sew section 1-2 with 3-4, right sides together



- Take the 2½ square from fabric **A** and place it on point on the center of the sewn block.
- Take the folded edge side of fabric **B** and folded towards fabric **A**.
- Carefully sew an edge stitch with a contrasting thread or thread of your choice.
- Repeat the same step for the other three sides.




DIAGRAM 4

- Creating the loop:
- Take one (1)  $3'' \times 1^{\frac{1}{2}''}$  strip from fabric **B**.
- Fold the edges to the center for fabric **B** strip and then fold in half.
- Sew the edges with matching thread.






DIAGRAM 5

- Cut template 1 with fabric C.
- Place it on top of the sewn block right sides together (See diagram below).
- Fold the strip from fabric **B** creating the loop and place the raw edges facing out in between the front of the pin cushion and the back of the pin cushion. Pin in place.
- Sew at <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" all around leaving around an 1" opening to insert stuffing batting.
- Turn it inside out and close the 1" opening by hand.
- Refer to diagram 6,7,8.
