Fabric **C**

- One (1) template L1.
- One (1) template L2.
- One (1) template L3.
- One (1) template L4.
- One (1) template L5.
- One (1) template L6.
- One (1) template L7.
- One (1) template L8.

Fabric **D**

- One (1) template Half Cir #2.

Fabric **E**

- One (1) template M .

Fabric **F**

- One (1) template La1.
- One (1) template La2.
- One (1) template La3.
- One (1) template La4.
- One (1) template La5.

Fabric **G**

- One (1) template Half Cir #1.

Fabric **H**

- One (1) template Quarter cir #3.

Fabric **I**

- One (1) template Cir.
- Two (2) 4" x 3½" rectangles .

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance.

- Start by placing template half Cir #1 on top of template Cir from fabric **A** following the notches, add some batting under both pieces and quilt as desired.
- Secure the edges with a decorative stitch.

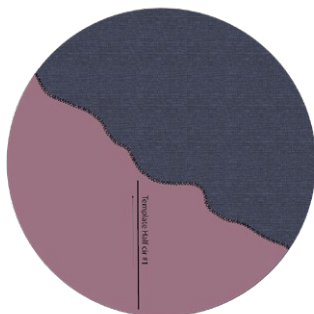


DIAGRAM 1

- Place template half Cir#2 from fabric **D** over the circle following the notches and the circle's curve.
- Use decorative stitch following the curves.

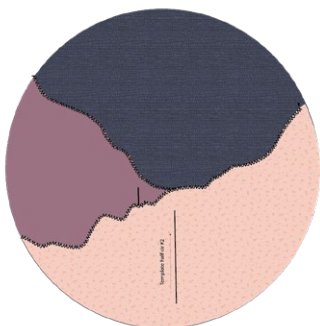


DIAGRAM 2

- Using template Quater Cir #3, cut batting ¼" smaller all around and then place it between template Quater Cir #3 from fabric **H** and the rest of the working area following the notches and the circle's curve.
- Use decorative stitch following the curves.



DIAGRAM 3

- Using steam-a-seam place templates L1, L2, L3, L4, L5, L6, L7 and L8 from fabric **C**, following the map on page 25 for better accuracy. Stitch each template using your favorite decorative stitch.



DIAGRAM 4

- Using steam-a-seam, place templates La1, La2, La3, La4 and La5 from fabric **F**, following the map on page 25 for better accuracy. Stitch each template using your favorite decorative stitch.



DIAGRAM 5

- Using steam-a-seam, place templates Lb1, Lb2, Lb3, Lb4, Lb5 and Lb6 from fabric **B**, following the map on page 25 for better accuracy. Stitch each template using your favorite decorative stitch.



DIAGRAM 6

- Using template M cut batting $\frac{1}{4}$ " smaller.
- Place template M. Batting in between template M from fabric **E**, following the map on page 25 for better accuracy. Stitch the template using your favorite decorative stitch.
- Once your Wall art top is done, quilt it as desired.



DIAGRAM 7

BACKING

- Sew each one of your 5" x 3½" rectangles at a ¼" on the longer side, turn them inside out to make the loops to hang the wall art.
- Measure 3" from center top down from template Cir from fabric **I**. Once you have that point, measure 3" to the left and 3" to the right.

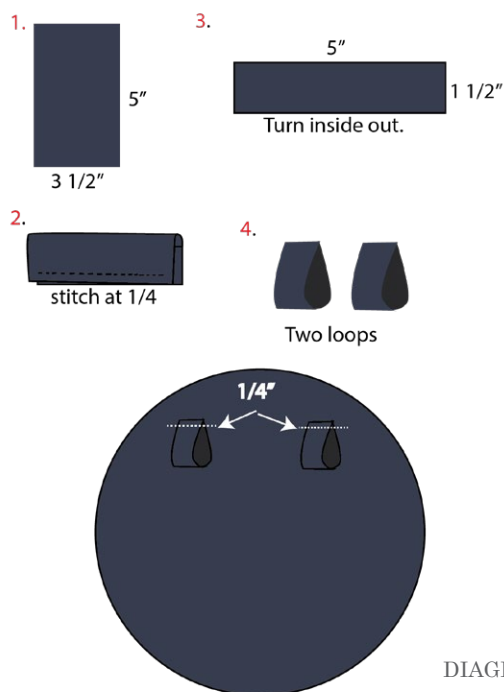


DIAGRAM 8

- Place your loops downwards, sew at a $\frac{1}{4}$ ", fold up and stitch at $\frac{1}{4}$ " again to hide the raw edges and to keep your loops up.

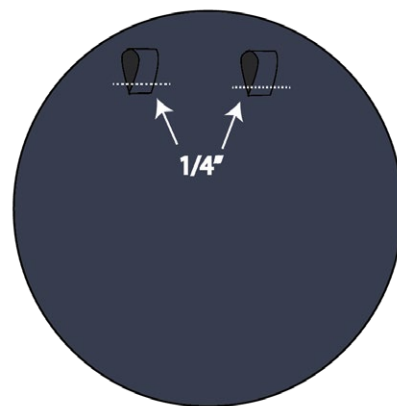


DIAGRAM 9

- Place your Wall Art and backing right sides together and stitch at a ¼" around leaving a space to turn it inside out.
- Once is inside out, sew shut the open space and voila, your Wall art is ready to hang and enjoy.

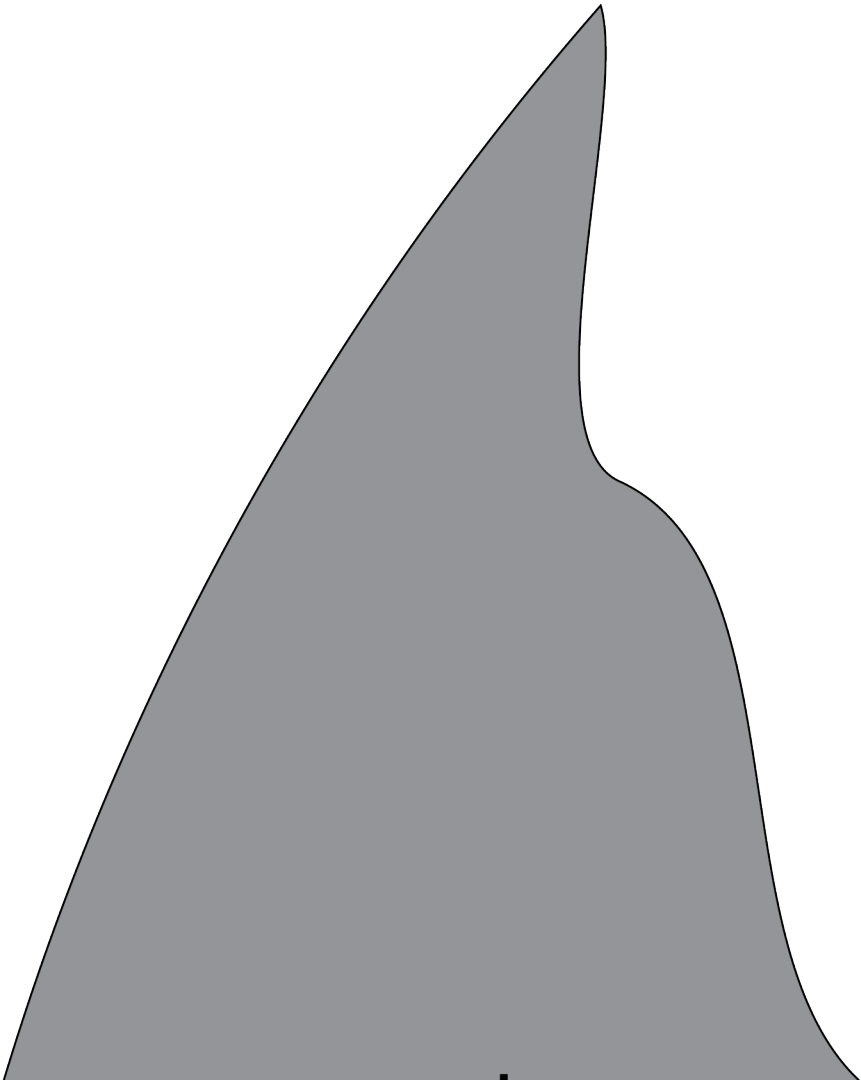
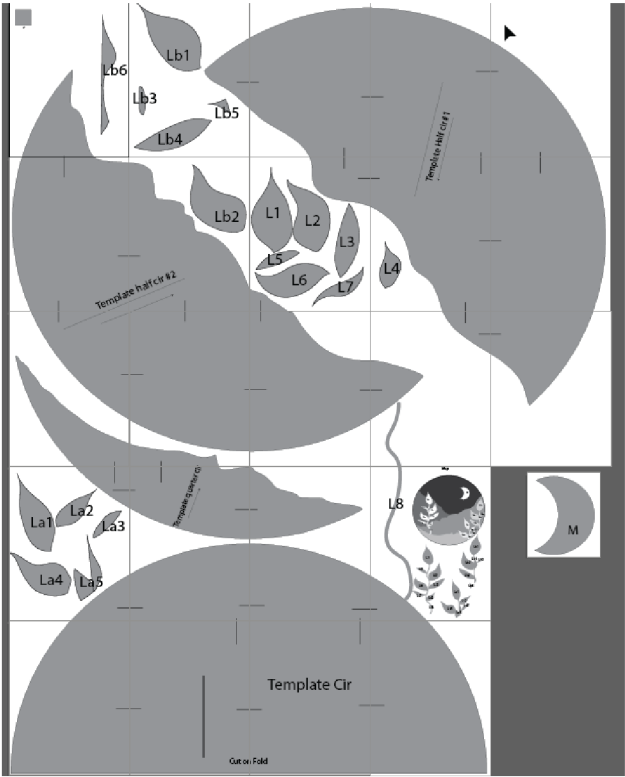
