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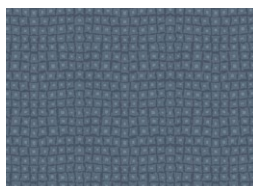

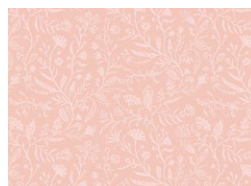

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric **A** MDS53902 ½ yd.

Fabric **B** MDS63902 2 yd.

Fabric **C** MDS63905 ½ yd.

Fabric **D** MDS53910 2 yd.

### BACKING FABRIC

Fabric **B** MDS63902 1 yd (Included)

Fabric **D** MDS53910 1 yd (Included)

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

¼" seam allowances are included.  
WOF means width of fabric.

### Pillow 1

Fabric **A**

- Four (4) 15" x 2" rectangles .
- Four (4) 12" x 2" rectangles.
- Four (4) 10½" x 2" rectangles.
- Four (4) 7½" x 2" rectangles.
- Eight (8) 4½" x 2" rectangles.
- Eight (8) 2" squares.

Fabric **B**

- Four (4) 12" x 3½" rectangles.
- Four (4) 10½" x 3½" rectangles.
- Four (4) 7½" x 3½" rectangles.
- Four (4) 6" x 2" rectangles.
- Four (4) 4½" x 3" rectangles.
- Four (4) 3" x 2" rectangles.
- Four (4) 15" x 2" rectangles.

### Pillow 2

Fabric **C**

- Four (4) 15" x 2" rectangles .
- Four (4) 12" x 2" rectangles.
- Four (4) 10½" x 2" rectangles.
- Four (4) 7½" x 2" rectangles.
- Eight (8) 4½" x 2" rectangles.
- Eight (8) 2" squares.
- Fabric **D**
- Four (4) 12" x 3½" rectangles.
- Four (4) 10½" x 3½" rectangles.
- Four (4) 7½" x 3½" rectangles.
- Four (4) 6" x 2" rectangles.
- Four (4) 4½" x 3" rectangles.
- Four (4) 3" x 2" rectangles.
- Four (4) 15" x 2" rectangles.

# CONSTRUCTION

*Sew all rights sides together with  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.*

## Construction of Block 1:

- Join one (1) 2" square from fabric **A** with one 3" x 2" rectangle from fabric **B**.
- Follow the diagram below.

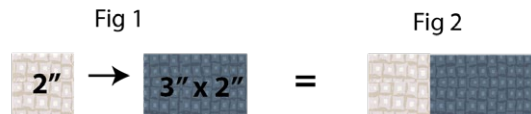


DIAGRAM 1

- Sew one (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" rectangle from fabric **B** right sides together to the bottom of the previously sewn piece (Fig 2).
- Follow the diagram below

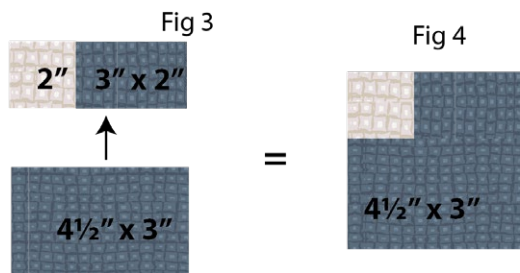


DIAGRAM 2

- Sew one (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" from fabric **A** on each side of the previously sewn piece ( Fig 4).
- Follow the diagram below.

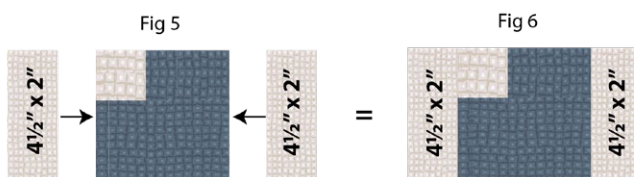


DIAGRAM 3

- Sew one (1) 6" x 2" rectangle from fabric **B** with one (1) 2" square from fabric **A**.
- Follow the diagram below.

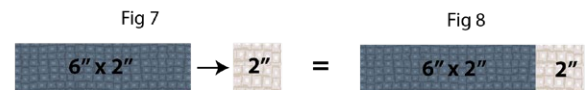


DIAGRAM 4

- Sew the last piece (Fig 8) right sides together to the upper part of the previously sewn piece (Fig 6).
- Follow the diagram below.

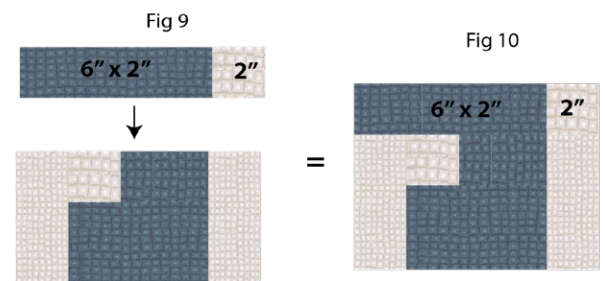


DIAGRAM 5

- Sew one (1)  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" rectangle from fabric **A** right sides together onto the bottom of the previously sewn piece ( fig 10) .
- Follow the diagram below.

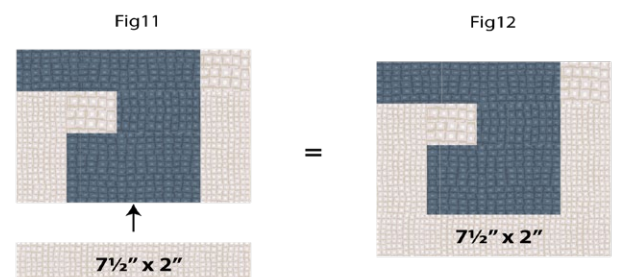


DIAGRAM 6



- Sew one (1)  $7\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B** right sides together onto the left side of the previously sewn piece (fig 12) .
- Follow the diagram below.

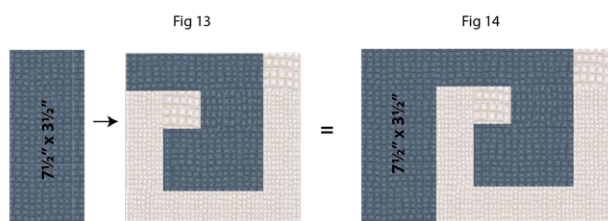


DIAGRAM 7

- Sew one (1)  $10\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B** onto the bottom part of the previously sewn piece (Fig 14).
- Follow the diagram below.

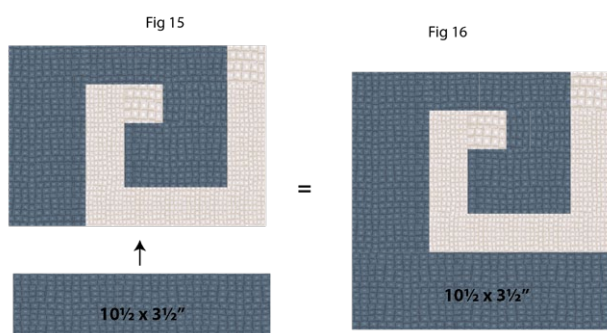


DIAGRAM 8

- Sew one (1)  $10\frac{1}{2} \times 2$ " rectangle from fabric **A** right sides together onto the top of the previously sewn piece (Fig 16).
- Follow the diagram below.

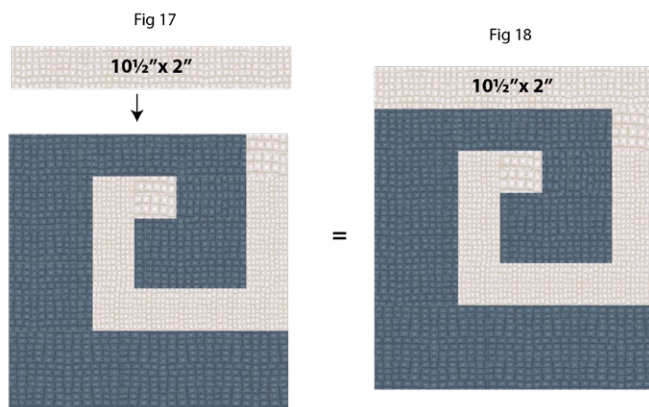


DIAGRAM 9

- Sew one (1)  $12 \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B** right sides together onto the right side of the previously sewn piece (Fig 18).
- Follow the diagram below.

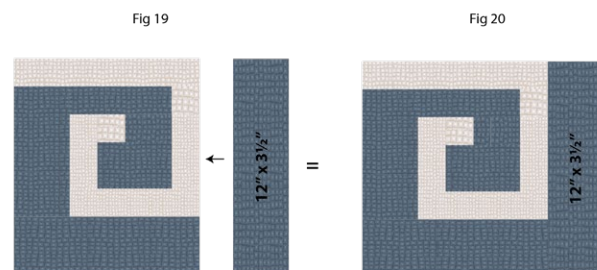


DIAGRAM 10

- Sew one (1)  $12 \times 2$ " rectangle from fabric **A** right sides together onto the left side of the previously sewn piece (Fig 20) .
- Follow the diagram below.

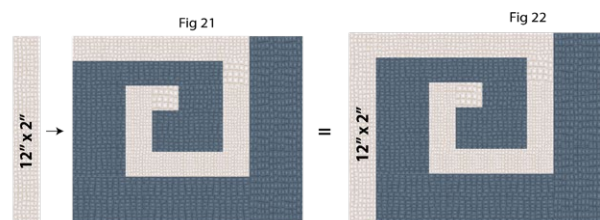


DIAGRAM 11

- Sew one (1)  $15 \times 2$ " rectangle from fabric **A** right sides together onto the bottom of the previously sewn piece (Fig 22) .
- Follow the diagram below.

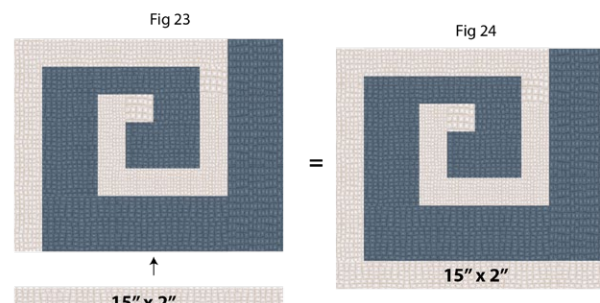


DIAGRAM 12

- Sew one (1) 15" x 2" rectangle from fabric **B** onto the upper part of the previously sewn piece (Fig 24) .
- Follow the diagram below.

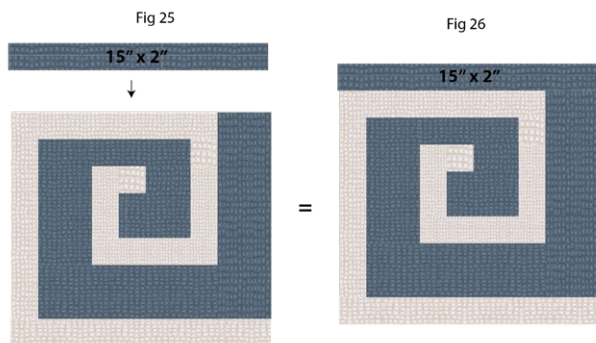


DIAGRAM 13

- You will need two (2) **Block 1**
- Follow the diagram below.

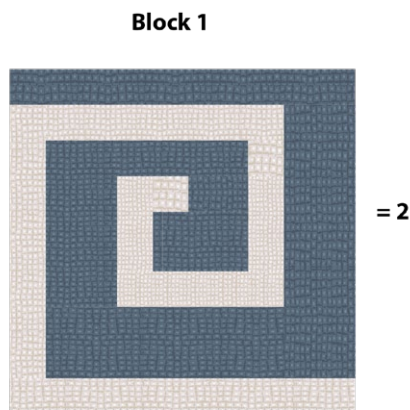

### Construction of Block 2:

- Join one (1) 3" x 2" rectangle from fabric **B** with one (1) 2" square from fabric **A**

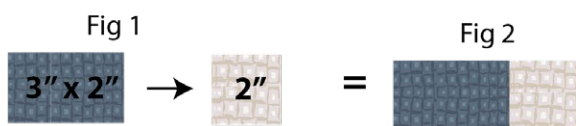


DIAGRAM 15

- Sew one (1) 4½" x 3" rectangle from fabric **B** right sides together to the bottom of the previously sewn piece (Fig 2).
- Follow the Diagram below.

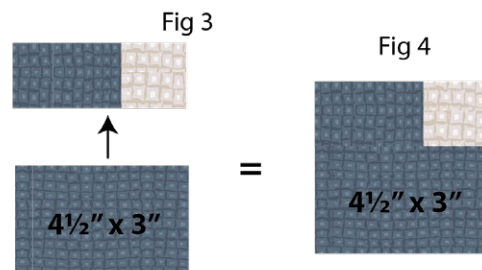


DIAGRAM 16

- Sew two (2) 4½" x 2" rectangles from fabric **A** on each side of the previously sewn piece (Fig 4).
- Follow the Diagram below.

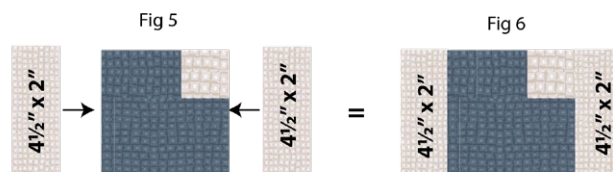


DIAGRAM 17

- Sew one (1) 2" square from fabric **A** with one (1) 6" x 2" square from fabric **B**.
- Follow the diagram below.

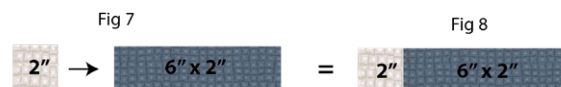


DIAGRAM 18

- Sew the last piece ( Fig 8) right sides together to the upper part of the previously sewn piece (Fig 6).
- Follow the diagram below.



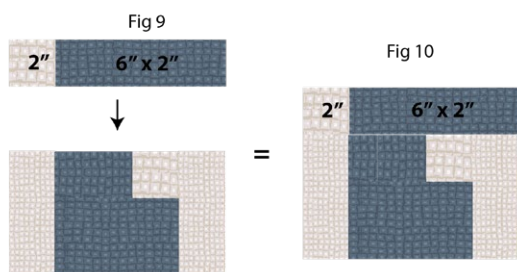


DIAGRAM 19

- Sew one (1)  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" rectangle from fabric **A** right sides together onto the bottom of the previously sewn piece (fig 10).
- Follow the diagram below.

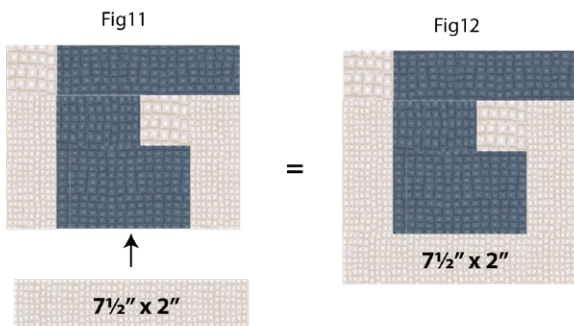


DIAGRAM 20

- Sew one (1)  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B** right sides together onto the right side of the previously sewn piece ( fig 12).
- Follow the diagram below.

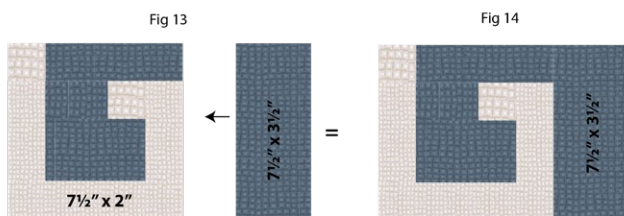


DIAGRAM 21

- Sew one (1)  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B** onto the bottom part of the previously sewn piece (Fig 14).
- Follow the diagram below.

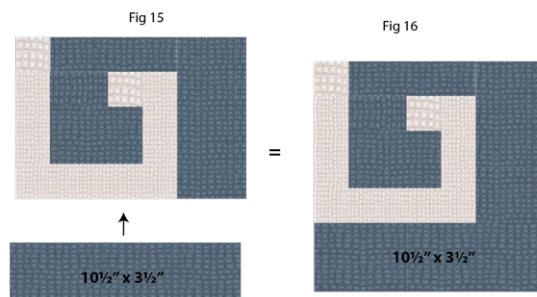


DIAGRAM 22

- Sew one (1)  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" rectangle from fabric **A** right sides together onto the top of the previously sewn piece (Fig 16).
- Follow the diagram below.

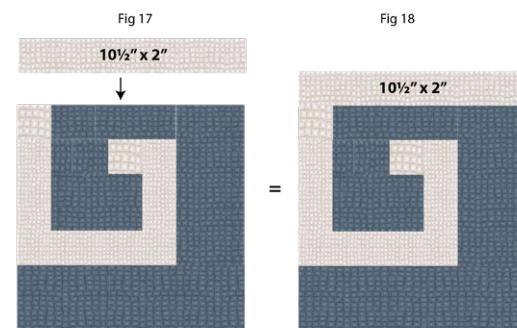


DIAGRAM 23

- Sew one (1) 12" x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric **B** right sides together onto the left side of the previously sewn piece (Fig 18).
- Follow the diagram below.

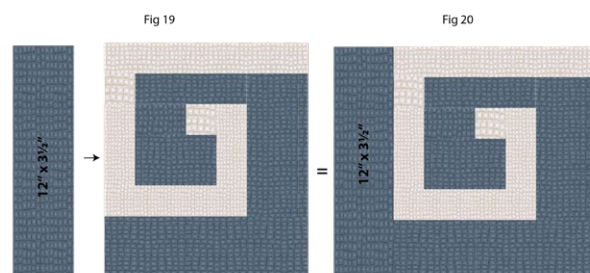


DIAGRAM 24

- Sew one (1) 12" x 2" rectangle from fabric **A** right sides together onto the right side of the previously sewn piece (Fig 20) .
- Follow the diagram below.

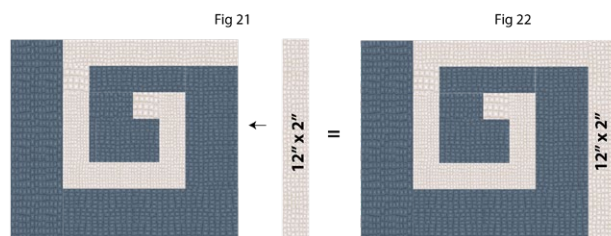


DIAGRAM 25

- Sew one (1) 15" x 2" rectangle from fabric **A** right sides together onto the bottom of the previously sewn piece (Fig 22).
- Follow the diagram below.

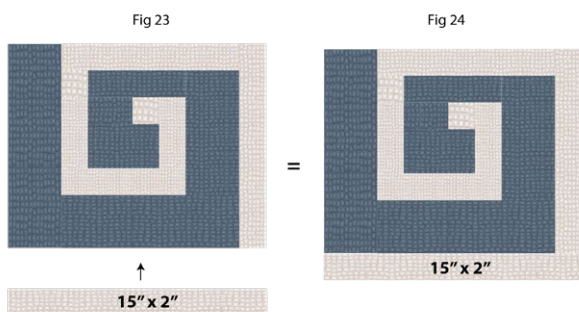


DIAGRAM 26

- Sew one (1) 15" x 2" rectangle from fabric **B** onto the upper part of the previously sewn piece (Fig 24).
- Follow the diagram below.

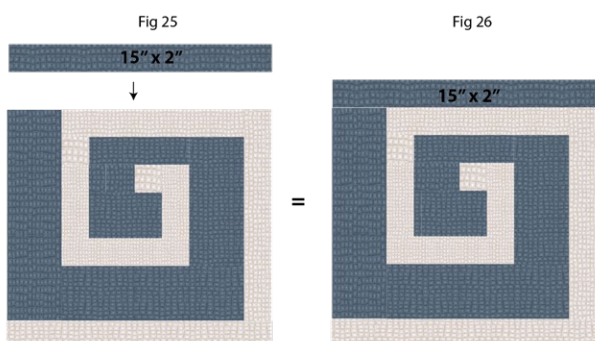


DIAGRAM 27

- You will need two (2) **Block 2**

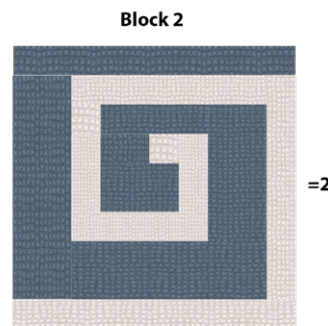

### Constructing your Floor pillow:

- You will need two (2) Blocks 1 and two (2) blocks 2.
- Sew one (1) Block 1 and one (1) Block 2 together as shown on the diagram.
- Repeat this one (1) more time.

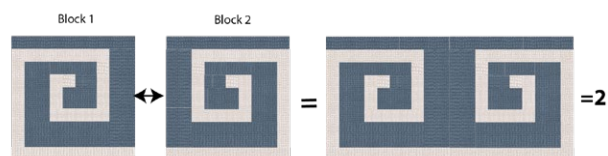


DIAGRAM 29

- Once you have the two (2) sets sewn, only one (1) needs to be rotated 180° so that it looks mirrored.
- Follow diagram below.

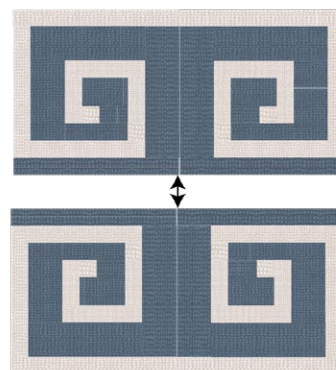
