

MATERIALS YOU'LL NEED:

- Juniper Collection Fabrics Scraps.
- Leaves templates by AGF.
- Scissors.
- Sewing machine or needle and thread.
- Stuffing (Poly-fill).
- Erasable pen or chalk.
- Embroidery floss.
- Wooden stick or pencil.
- Rope or twine for hanging.

Gather all your materials before you start. Make sure you have your leaves templates ready.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS



You can use two different colors for a nice contrast.



CONSTRUCTION

1. Sew The Pieces Together:

Place two leaf shapes together with the right sides **facing each other**.

Use a sewing machine or hand-sew around the edge, leaving a small gap of 1¹/₂" to turning the leaf inside out.





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2. Snip on each concave

Snip small notches along the concave parts of the leaf to help it turn inside out more easily.

3. Turn the Leaf Inside Out:

Use a wooden stick or pencil to gently push the edges of the leaf out through the gap.

Ensure the points of the leaf are well-defined.

4. Add Stuffing:

Carefully stuff the leaf with the stuffing of your choice to give it a plump appearance.

Close the gap by stitching it shut, either by hand or edge Stitch.

5. Marking leaves' veins:

Use an erasable pen or chalk to mark the leaves' veins.

6. Add Embellishment:

With embroidery floss, sew along the marked veins using the backstitch. Once you've sewn the veins, finish the last one, and tie off the thread. 7. Attach the Garland Rope:

Measure the desired length you want your garland to be and the spaces between every leaf.

Stitch the rope through the top of each leaf to create your garland.
