# FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric 🗛	DSY24404	3/4.
Fabric B	DSY24408	FQ.
Fabric C	PE478	F8.

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

"4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of the fabric.

#### Fabric A

• Fourteen (14) petal templates.

#### Fabric **B**

• Seven (7) petal applique templates.

### Fabric C

- Two (2) front cirlce template.
- Two (2) back circle template.

# CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with 1/4" seam allowance.

- Start by placing the petal applique from fabric B over one petal template from fabric A, pin in place and with a matching color thread and using blanket or zig zag stitch sew al around fabric B.
- Repeat this step six (6) more times for a total of 7 petals. See diagram below for reference.




DIAGRAM 1

 Now, take one (1) of the previously sewn pieces and sew it to one (1) petal template from fabric A right sides facing each other and leave a 2" to 3" opening to turn your petal right side out. Repeat the same step with the other six (6) petals. See diagram below for reference.




DIAGRAM 2

 Turn your petals right side out, stuff them with pillow stuffing (Poly-Fil) and close the opening by hand.  Once your petals are ready, place them in the shape of a daisy flower and with a needle and thread baste stitch all together. See diagram below for reference.



DIAGRAM 3

- Take two (2) template front circle from fabric
   and sew them right side facing each other leaving an opening.
- Turn the piece inside out and stuff it as you did with the petalas. Close the opening by hand.
- See diagrams below for reference.




DIAGRAM 4

 Place the previously sewn circle in the middle of the flower and with needle and thread attach it to the flower. See diagram below for reference.




DIAGRAM 5

• This is how the pillow will look from the front.

• Since the back of the flower will show the stitches and the raw edges, take two (2) back template circle and sew them right sides together, leaving a space to turn it inside out. Once turned close the opening by hand. Place the the back template on the back of the flower and stitch it by hand. Your Flower Pillow is ready!



