## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.

- Four (4) $5^{11 / 2 "} \times 3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles from Fabric A
- Four (4) $3^{11 / 2 "} \times 2^{11} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles from Fabric A
- Four (4) $1^{11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 ⁄ 2 " ~ r e c t a n g l e ~ f r o m ~ F a b r i c ~ A ~}$
- Eight (8) $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares from Fabric B
- Five (5) $2 ½$ " squares from Fabric C


## CONSTRUCTION

Sesw all rights sides together with 1/4"seam allowance.

- Pair (1) $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2 "}$ " rectangle from Fabric A with one $2^{112} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from Fabric B.
- Repeat the same process in order to have a total of 4 units of Fabric A-B


DIAGRAM 1

- Sew one (1) $5^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle from Fabric $A$ on each side of one (1) A-B.
- Repeat this step one more time.


DIAGRAM 2

- Join three (3) $2^{11 / 2 "}$ squares from Fabric C and two (2) A-B units as shown on the diagram below


DIAGRAM 3

- Join one (1) $3^{1} 12^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle from Fabric A and one (1) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from Fabric $B$.
- Repeat 3 more times as in the diagram below, you will have a total of 4 units.


DIAGRAM 4

- Take two (2) units sewn on diagram 4 and sew on each side of one (1) $2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ square from Fabric C.
- Repeat this step one more time.


DIAGRAM 5

- Sew all rows previously made as shown on diagram below

- Quilt as desired
- If you want to create the other blocks, repeat the same instructions as above.
