BACKING FABRIC

PE439 FQ (Suggested)

Our Fat Quarter measurement is 22" x 18". Our Fat Eight measurement is 11" x 18".

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Please ensure that all fabrics are ironed thoroughly before cutting them. ¹/₄" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of the fabric.

Fabric A

- Two (2) 12¹/₂" x ³/₄" strips.
- Two (2) 12" x ³/₄" strips.
- One (1) 7" x 2" rectangle.
- Two (2) 3" x 2" rectangles.
- Six (6) 1¹/₂" x 2" rectangles.
- Ten (10) 1¹/₄" x 2" rectangles.
- Four (4) 4" x 1¹/₂" rectangles.
- Four (4) 2¹/₂" x 1¹/₂" rectangles.
- Four (4) 1¹/₂" squares.

Fabric B

- Four (4) 4³/₄" x 2" rectangles.
- Four (4) 3¹/₄" x 2" rectangles.

Fabric C

- Two (2) 2¹/₄ x 2" rectangles.
- Six (6) 2" squares.
- Four (4) 1¹/₂" x 2" rectangles.
- Four (4) $1" \times 1^{\frac{1}{2}}$ rectangles.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

- Sew one (1) 1¹/₂" square from fabric A and one (1) 1" x 1¹/₂" rectangle from fabric C.
- Follow diagram:



DIAGRAM 1

- Sew the previously sewn piece and one (1) 2" square from fabric C together.
- Follow diagram:



DIAGRAM 2

- Sew the piece from Diagram 2 and one (1) 1½" x 2" rectangle of fabric A together. Follow diagram:
- Set piece aside



DIAGRAM 3

- Sew one (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" rectangle from fabric C and one (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle from fabric A together.
- Follow diagram:



- Sew one (1) piece from Diagram 3 and one (1) from Diagram 4 together.
- Follow diagram:



DIAGRAM 5

- Sew one (1) 4" x 1¹/₂" rectangle from fabric A and the previously sewn piece together.
- Set piece aside.



DIAGRAM 6

- Sew one (1) 1¹/₄" x 2" rectangle from fabric A and one (1) 3¹/₄" x 2" rectangle from fabric B together.
- Follow diagram:



DIAGRAM 7

- Sew one (1) piece from Diagram 6 and one (1) piece from Diagram 7 together.
- Follow diagram:



Take one 1¹/₄" x 2" rectangle from fabric A and one
(1) 4³/₄" x 2" rectangle from fabric B and sew them together.



DIAGRAM 9

- Sew the previously sewn strip to the bottom of the block from Diagram 8. We will call these BL
- Repeat these steps three (3) more times for a total of four (4) BL.
- Set aside.



DIAGRAM 10

- Take one (1) 1¹/₂" x 2" rectangle from fabric A one (1) 2" square from fabric C and one (1) 3" x 2" rectangle from fabric A and sew them together.
- Repeat this step one (1) more time to have a total of two
 (2) strips.



DIAGRAM 11

- Take two (2) BL and one (1) ACA and sew them together as shown on the diagram:
- Repeat the same steps one (1) more time.



DIAGRAM 12

• Take one (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2" rectangle from fabric A, one (1) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2" rectangle from fabric C one (1) 7" x 2" rectangle from fabric A, one (1) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2" rectangle from fabric C and one (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2" rectangle from fabric A and sew them together.

• Follow diagram:



DIAGRAM 13

- Take the previously sewn pieces from Diagram 12 and Diagram 13 and sew them together.
- Follow diagram:

- Sew two (2) 12¹/₂" x ³/₄" strips from fabric A to the top and bottom of your block.
- Follow diagram:
