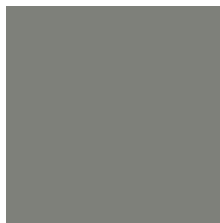

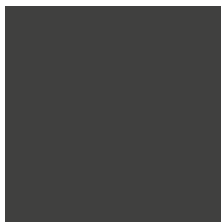

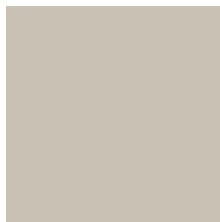

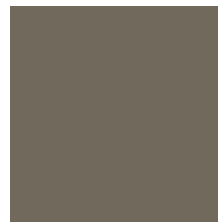

Fabric F	PE479	1/4 yd.
Fabric G	PE469	1/4 yd.
Fabric H	PE480	1/8 yd.
Fabric I	DSE700	1 yd.
Fabric J	PE548	3/8 yd.

BACKING FABRIC

PE431 1 1/2 yds. (Suggested)

BINDING FABRIC

PE548 Fabric **J** (Included)

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.

- One (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip from fabric **A**, then sub-cut strip into four (4) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- Two (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips from fabric **B**, then sub-cut strips into four (4) 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- Two (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips from fabric **C**, then sub-cut strip into four (4) 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" strips.
- One (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip from fabric **D**, then sub-cut strip into six (6) 3 1/2" squares.
- One (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip from fabric **E**, then sub-cut strip into four (4) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- Two (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips from fabric **F**, then sub-cut strips into four (4) 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.

- Two (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips from fabric **G**, then sub-cut strips into four (4) 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" strips.
- One (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip from fabric **H**, then sub-cut strip into six (6) 3 1/2" squares.
- Four (4) 12 1/2" squares from fabric **I**.
- Eight (8) 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips from fabric **I**.
- Eight (8) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips from fabric **I**.
- Eight (8) 3 1/2" squares from fabric **I**.
- Five (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips from fabric **J**. (Binding)

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with 1/4" seam allowance.

There are two block combinations for the construction of this quilt.

Follow the instructions below for the constructions of block **a**.

- Start the construction of block **a** by taking one 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" strip from fabric **I** and one 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip from fabric **A**.
- Lay strip **I** on the right side of strip **A** making a right angle, with strip **I** extending up.
- Draw a line using an erasable fabric marker from the upper right corner to the lower left intersection.
- Sew along the line **DIAGRAM 1**.
- Trim away the excess fabric leaving 1/4" seam allowance.
- Press open.

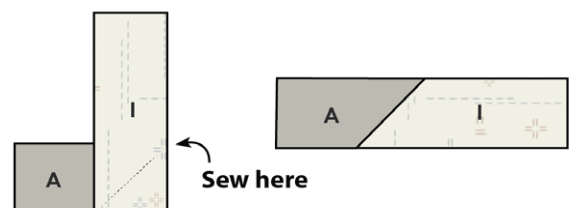


DIAGRAM 1

- Take one 3½" x 9½" strip from fabric **I** and one 3½" x 6½" strip from fabric **A**.
- Lay strip **I** on the right side of strip **A** making a right angle, with strip **I** extending down.
- Draw a line using an erasable fabric marker from the upper left corner to the lower right intersection.
- Sew along the line **DIAGRAM 2**.
- Trim away the excess fabric leaving ¼" seam allowance.
- Press open.

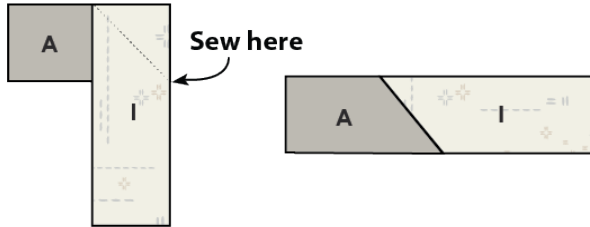


DIAGRAM 2

- Take one 3½" square from fabric **D** and attach it to the bottom of piece **IA** from **DIAGRAM 1**.
- Press towards fabric **D**.



DIAGRAM 3

- Take the piece **IA** that is left and one 12½" square from fabric **I**.
- Sew the square from fabric **I** to the top of the strip **IA**.

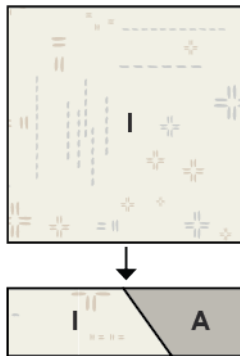


DIAGRAM 4

- Take the **IA** strip and attach it to the right side of the piece previously sewn.

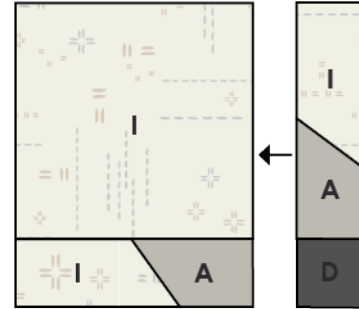


DIAGRAM 5

- Take one 3½" x 6½" strip from fabric **I** and one 3½" x 12½" from fabric **B**.
- Using the same process shown in **DIAGRAM 1** sew the strip from fabric **I** to the right side of the strip from fabric **B**.
- Draw a line using an erasable fabric marker from the upper right corner to the lower left intersection.
- Sew along the line.
- Trim away the excess fabric leaving ¼" seam allowance.



DIAGRAM 6

- Take one 3½" x 6½" strip from fabric **I** and one 3½" x 12½" from fabric **B**.
- This time use the same process shown in **DIAGRAM 2** sew the strip from fabric **I** to the right side of the strip from fabric **B**.
- Draw a line using an erasable fabric marker from the upper left corner to the lower right intersection.
- Sew along the line.
- Trim away the excess fabric leaving ¼" seam allowance.
- Press open.
